Proper for Today's Mass: The texts for the Sunday Mass may be found on page 328 in the *St. Edmund Campion Missal & Hymnal*.

A Note on Assisting at Mass: At Mass, for the entrance and departure of the priest, to stand is the customary and sufficient gesture of reverence for him; a bow is not customary. The following guidelines are found in *American Catholic Etiquette* (Kay Toy Fenner, 1961):

"General rules for following the Mass, disregarding slight differences in custom in various localities, are these:

[For Low Mass] Stand when the priest enters the sanctuary at the beginning of mass; remain standing until he begins the Prayers at the

Foot of the Altar, then kneel...," etc. At the end of Mass, "Kneel for the Prayers after Mass. Respond to the prayers. Stand until the priest has left the altar."

[For a Sung or Solemn Mass] "Stand when the priest enters the sanctuary.... If the *Asperges* is to be given before the High Mass (permissible only at the principal Mass on Sundays), stand until the celebrant passes the pew one is occupying; kneel as one receives the *Asperges*; then stand until the *Asperges* is concluded... remain standing until the priest begins the Prayers at the Foot of the Altar, then kneel ...," etc. At the end of Mass, "Stand for the Last Gospel... Stand until the priest and acolytes have left the altar."
