VISION STATEMENT

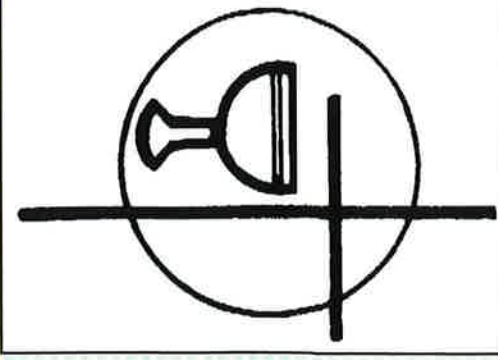
We endeavor to enrich the missionary hearts of the members of Corpus Christi Catholic Community by being of Christian service to the community of Tepeyac and surrounding area through:
