

The above quote is a great illustration of those who have supported the Tuition Sponsorship Program at St. John Bosco School. A few years ago Father Carl Schmitt and Dr. Amy Fogarty felt a passionate need to initiate a program that would support those students and their families who wanted to attend SJB, but needed financial assistance. It was their belief that money should never prevent families from obtaining a Catholic education. It was with their foresight and many generous donors in the past that last year we were able to financially assist all 31 children who requested aid.

Why give? Sponsoring a Catholic education for children in our community in need is a beautiful and selfless act. Those of us who have been blessed with abundance are charged with being good stewards of our blessings and to help those around us most in need. The act of giving brings us pleasure. It's the joy and love that we extend to others that brings true happiness and strengthens our relationship with God. When we give, we reap the joy of seeing a bright smile, laughter, tears of joy and gratitude. We know

when people give just a little bit more — of their time, skills, knowledge, wisdom, compassion, wealth and love — the world is a more peaceful and happier place.
