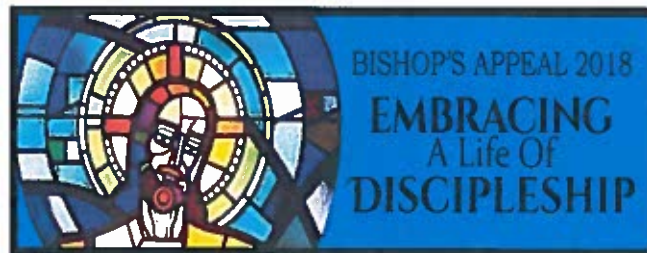

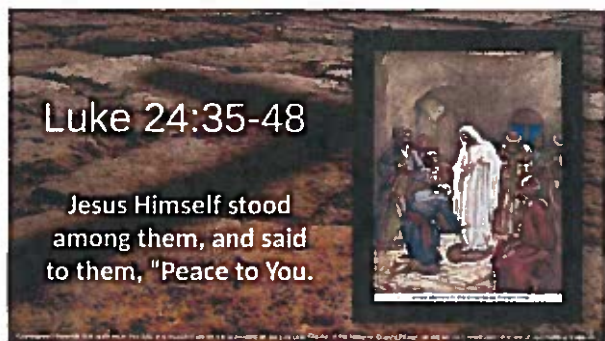

Walk for a Cause:The Adam LaLuzerne Scholarship Fund

Come join in prayer and fellowship on Saturday, May 5, 2018 at 8:00am at Corpus Christi Church. The Sturgeon Bay Catholic Community and Corpus Christi Parish are sponsoring a 1-or 3- mile Walk for a Cause. The money raised will benefit the Adam LaLuzerne Humanitarian Scholarship Fund. The scholarship is awarded to a Sturgeon Bay High School senior that has demonstrated an outstanding commitment to community service. Adam attended St. John Bosco, Sturgeon Bay High School, and graduated from St. Norbert College. Adam was involved with many volunteer organizations throughout his young life. He was an active member in Habitat for Humanity, St. Norbert Garden Club, TRIPS (Turning Responsibility into Powerful Service), Youth Works, a national mission service program, and Life Teen Mission trips as a member of Corpus Christi Catholic Church. Registration forms are available in the main entrance brochure rack of church and on the parish web site. The forms must be received by April 23 in order to guarantee a t-shirt. Event day registrations will be available. The 1- or 3- mile walk begins at 8am from the social hall, but is a staggered start, so come and walk any time from 8-10:00. Refreshments will be provided. This is a great way to raise money for the Adam LaLuzerne Scholarship Fund which will help to carry on Adam's legacy for community service.

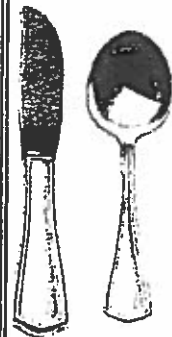
