New Memorial of 'The Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church'

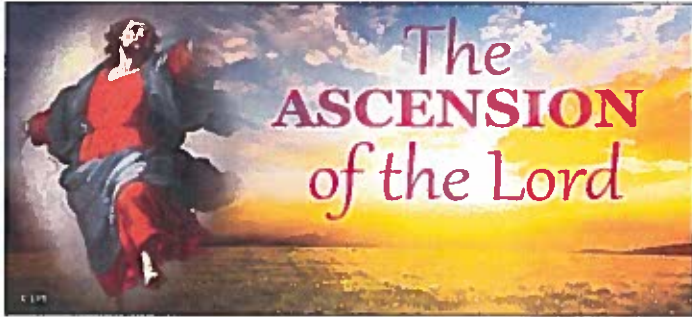
Monday after Pentecost

Dear parishioners,

In August of 2017, the city of Houston saw up to 51.8 inches of rain from Hurricane Harvey. The devastation across the southern United States is heartbreaking, and there are thousands of people who desperately need our help. We have an incredible group of high school students and adults who want to help. We will be heading to Houston, Texas in July to help rebuild from the Hurricane. As missionary disciples our goal is to help rebuild communities and restore hope to areas through meaningful and productive work projects.

Pope Francis recently said to the youth of the Church: "All together, then, we ask the Lord: "Launch us on the adventure of mercy!
