## From the Principal

**“Your talent is God’s gift to you. What you do with it is your gift back to God.”**

- Leo Buscaglia

We have all been given different talents, gifts, abilities. God works in different ways through each of us, and we all serve him faithfully as we use our gifts to glorify him. We should invest the gifts that God has blessed us with wisely. We should use our gifts and abilities to honor God and to bless, encourage and strengthen others *in love* (without love, all our gifts are nothing!). We should not neglect our gifts, but instead develop them, “stir them up”, “fan them into flames” ... so that they get even better, to the edification of the church and to the glory of God.

The above quote is a great illustration of those who have supported the Tuition Sponsorship Program at St. John Bosco School. A few years ago, Father Carl Schmitt and Dr. Amy Fogarty felt a passionate need to initiate a program that would support those students and their families who wanted to attend SJB but needed financial assistance. It was their belief that money should never prevent families from obtaining a Catholic education. It was with their foresight and many

generous donors in the past that last year we were able to financially assist all 35 children who needed aid.

**Why give?** Sponsoring a Catholic education for children in our community in need is a beautiful and selfless act. Those of us who have been blessed with abundance are charged with being good stewards of our blessings and to help those around us most in need. The act of giving brings us pleasure. It’s the joy and love that we extend to others that brings true happiness and strengthens our relationship with God. When we give, we reap the joy of seeing a bright smile, laughter, tears of joy and gratitude. We know when people give just a little bit more – of their time, talent, knowledge, wisdom, compassion, wealth and love – the world is a more peaceful and happier place. I believe true giving – that done without expectation of reciprocation – makes you happier. But don’t take my word for it – try it out for yourself. The truth is without tuition sponsorship over 28% of our students would not be able to afford a Catholic education.

**What to give?** This month we are again beginning our annual tuition sponsorship program. We are already aware of more children in need of aid. Therefore, I would like to focus on not only sustaining those donations, but also increasing them. Many donors have chosen to sponsor

one, or more child(ren). Contributions can be made on a monthly or yearly basis thru automatic withdrawal from a specified account, credit card or check.
