The **Door County Wisconsin Chapter of the Christ Child Society** is a non-denominational, non-profit 501(c)(3) group of involved volunteers who have come together to meet the needs of children and families in the Door County community in practical ways. We are moved by our motto, "*Nothing is ever too much to do for a child*".

Our **layette program** provides essentials for babies. Many items included in the layette, like quilts, sweaters, hats and socks, burp cloths and bibs are handmade by our members. We also purchase onesies, sleepers, diapers, bottles, and books. Mothers experience the joy of going home with a layette of necessities and with less fear of having little. Our **One-on-one program** is set in action by a call from one of the Social Service Agencies in the county. They may be calling for a car seat, crib and mattress, diapers or needed clothing. Our **School support program** helps children return to school each year with necessary supplies and some clothing for a better chance of success. Our **Shaken Baby Syndrome** classes taught at the High schools explain how only a moment of unbridled frustration of a caregiver can devastate the life of a child or cause death. We are striving to **Challenge Poverty through Education and Literacy**. We have founded a Moving Ahead Award to improve education and career potential for a struggling but determined parent. **You can help our children** by becoming an active member or a donor.
