Marriage Minute:

Prioritizing your marriage is not a “nice extra” but rather the way in which you prove your love for God. Sometimes that can mean sacrificing outside activities in order to be more intentional at home. Start with simple things:

- Home for dinner together as a family
- Screens off when you are with your spouse and children
- Pray with your spouse and children
- Hold your tongue on criticism and notice the positive.
