**Sunday, October 7 at 1:00pm**

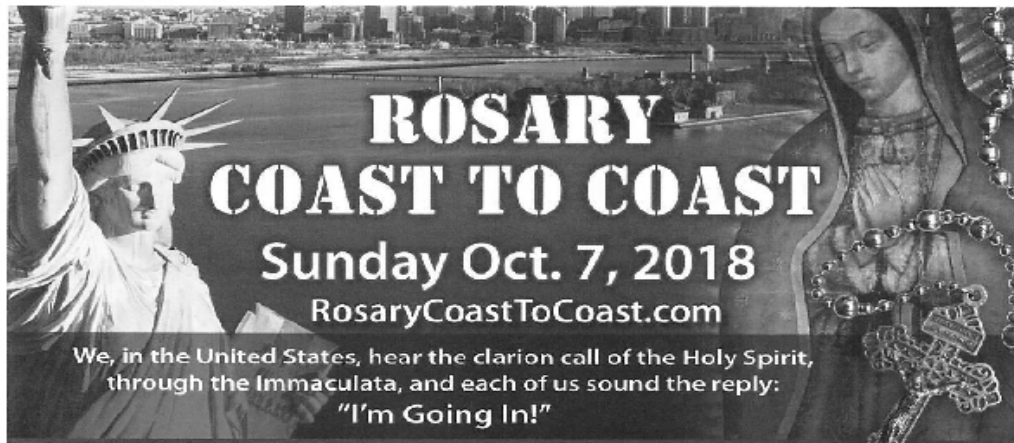
Catholics across the United States will be gathering at the same time to pray the Rosary in their churches and their homes.

If you cannot join us, consider praying the Rosary at home with family and friends at 1:00pm



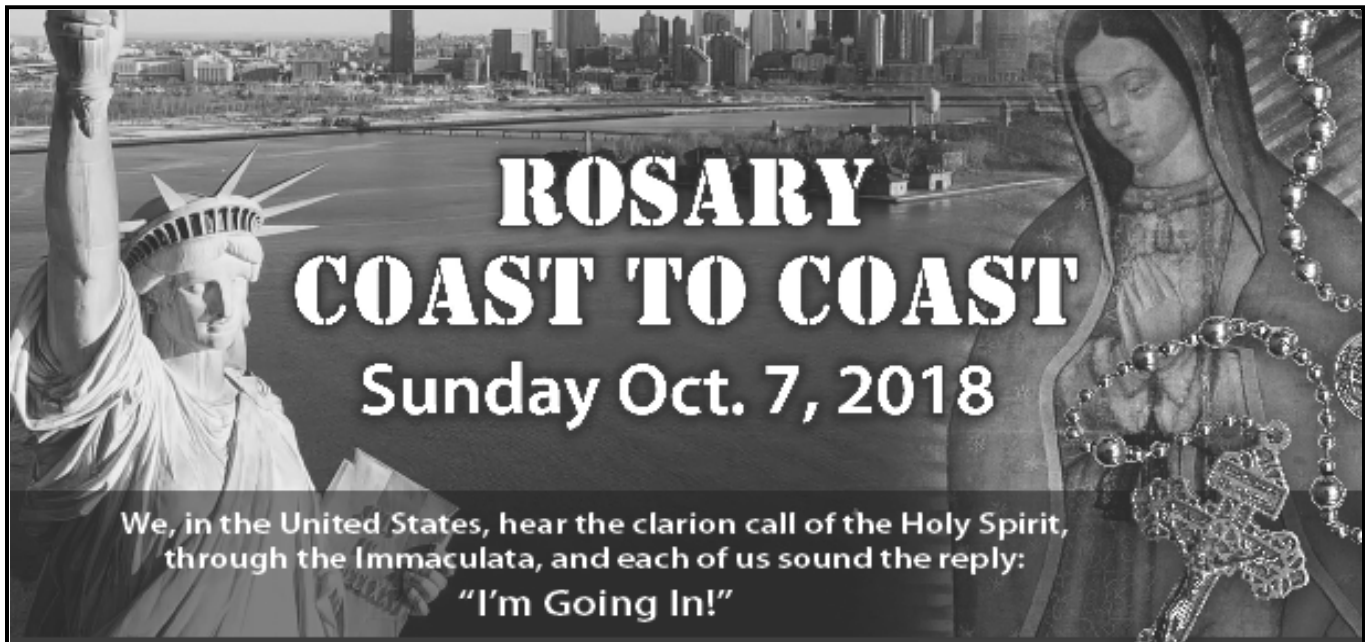

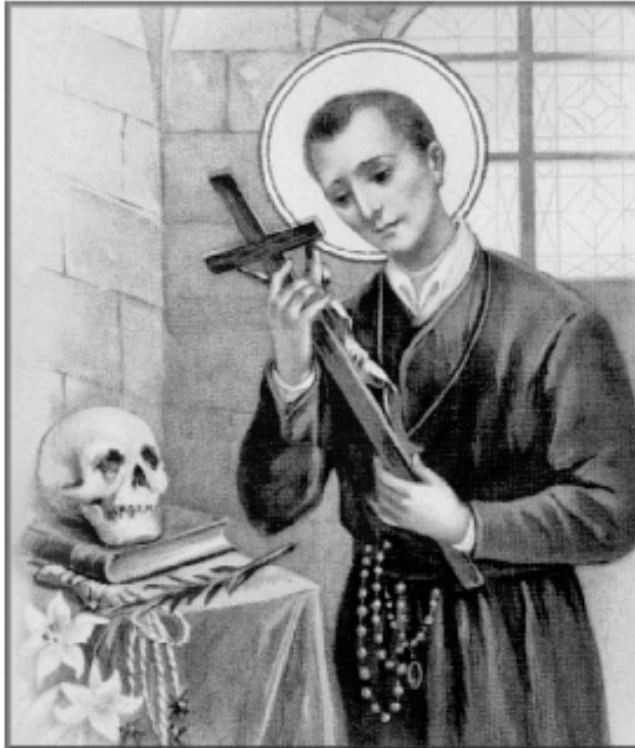

Your child will make many friends throughout his lifetime. As children grow, their interests change and develop, and they meet many new people along the way. But as children make new friends, mutual respect should be the guiding principle of these relationships.
