MEET FR. JUSTIN

It's already been two weeks since I made my home here in Malone and I thank Fr. Joe for his brotherly affection and warm welcome. I keep telling many of you that "I am already home." It's been my heartfelt pleasure to meet many of you in different places, especially in church, and now it's a blessing that I can reach every one of you by quoting a few lines about me here. I, Fr. Justin Thomas, am coming from a

state named Kerala, which lies in the Southern part of India. I have my parents at home and a younger brother, who has almost finished his studies and is looking for a job. I used to be an altar boy in my early days and that influenced me a lot to become a priest, and hence I joined the Missionary Society named "Heralds of Good News" after 10th grade. This order has St. Joseph and Mary, Queen of the Apostles, as patrons. It has 4 different provinces and I belong to the province named after Blessed Mother Theresa. I completed seminary and the entire priestly formation in another southern state called Andhra Pradesh, which is around 800 miles away from my hometown. Finally, with the blessings of God and the prayers of many, I was ordained as priest on May 11, 2011, in my parish. Soon, I was sent to a northeastern state named Assam where I stayed for 2 years in different seminaries carrying out the responsibilities as Administrator and Dean of Studies. And the last year I was assigned to promote vocations to my order, which I did fruitfully with the help of Christ. And now, I am here as part of your family. I feel really great and proud to join your community. My primary goal is to fulfill all your expectations to the best of my ability. I ask for all your prayers and support and at the same time I assure you sincerely of my prayers and assistance in all your necessary needs. May the good Lord watch over your families and keep you close to his Heart.

NFP makes use of periodic abstinence from sexual intercourse based on the woman's naturally occurring signs of fertility, in order to space births or to limit the number of children when there is a serious reason to do so...this practice fosters in couples an attitude of respect and wonder in the face of human life, which is sacred. It also fosters profound respect for one's spouse, which is necessary for authentic intimacy." (Marriage: Love and Life in the Divine Plan, USCCB, 2009, p. 20). SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents who wish to have a child baptized should contact Sister Barbara to make arrangements for the date and for a program of preparation. Parents are highly encouraged to make arrangements at least three months before the child is born, as the Catholic Church encourages Baptism for infants as soon as possible after birth. Adults and older children (seven years or older) interested in Baptism or entering into full communion with the Catholic Church should inquire about the program of preparation (R.C.I.A.: the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults).

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

A Catholic wishing to be married in one of our churches should contact one of the priests at least six months prior to the desired date in order to begin making arrangements. A program of preparation is required. The parish should be contacted before any other plans are made—for example, the wedding reception.

SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK

For those preparing for surgery, nursing home residents, or the homebound, contact one of the parish priests to make arrangements to be anointed. For those in the hospital (especially in the event of an emergency), ask the hospital staff to contact the priest on call.
