FROM FR. JOE...

It hard to believe, but our "new" Mass schedule has been in effect for nearly three months already...which means that we'll be heading back to St. Joseph's starting next weekend. Since it's also Palm Sunday,

**there are only two Masses next weekend
--4:00pm Saturday and 9:30am Sunday--
and they will both be held at St. Joseph's.**

This will be a great chance to bring our whole parish together to celebrate the start of Holy Week. Since all the other daily Masses have been at Notre Dame during the season of Lent, we will continue to have them there during the weekdays of Holy Week, too. Because there can be no anticipated (4:00pm) Mass for Easter, the next weekend Mass at St. Joseph's will be 4:00pm on Saturday, April 11.

(One other note on the Sunday Mass schedule: *it worked just the way it was supposed to* when I came down with a bad case of the flu last weekend. If we still had the old schedule in place, two Masses would have had to have been canceled at the very last minute. Fr. Justin had to move right along, but he was able to offer all three Masses on Sunday morning. I thank him for being such a good sport!)

This Tuesday will be our **The Light is ON for YOU, all-day confessions**. At least one priest will be available from 6:00am-10:00pm, with two priests during "high traffic" times (e.g. lunch break). Fr. Stitt has offered to help Fr. Justin and I with this, and we're grateful. Please take advantage of this opportunity to approach the Sacrament of Penance in preparation for Easter. Confessions will still be heard during our regularly scheduled times (Thursdays and Saturdays, except during Holy Week), but there will not be a Penance Service this Lent.
