FROM FR. JOE...


On this **All Saints Day**, we rejoice to have Bishop LaValley coming to town for the **dedication and blessing of Frassati House**, which will take place at 4:00pm at the conclusion of the open house there. I hope many of you will come by to see Frassati House (the St. John Bosco rectory, 57 Rennie St.) and meet the five missionaries who call it home. I also hope many of you will invite the missionaries *to your homes* in the weeks and months ahead. I asked this for myself when I first came to town, and now I ask on their behalf, because I know it's the best way they can get to know you, the parish, and how to reach the people of our community...not to mention that they're dynamic young people whose company I'm sure you'll enjoy!

This feast also marks the beginning of **National Vocations Awareness Week**. We need to be aware that each and every Christian has a vocation: the general call to holiness of life—the call to become saints—and a particular call to serve Christ and his Church, whether we're single or married, a lay person, consecrated religious, deacon, or priest. Let us support one another in our common vocation to grow in holiness, and let us encourage our young people to find their particular vocation—especially encouraging young men to consider the priesthood.

Monday is **All Souls Day**, and our observance of it includes a **special evening Mass (5:30pm) at St. Helen's**, followed by a procession into the cemetery and the blessing of graves. And as we continue throughout this month of November to pray for the souls of the faithful departed, we will be reading the names of all those who have died in the parish during the past year at each of the Masses next Sunday (November 7-8).

Last Saturday's **Turkey Dinner at St. Helen's** was a great success. We extend our gratitude to all the parishioners who volunteered their time, energy, and talents to make that the case—in particular, thanking the members of the Gadway family who do such a great job spearheading the event each year, and our Confirmation candidates who were especially helpful waiting on tables. 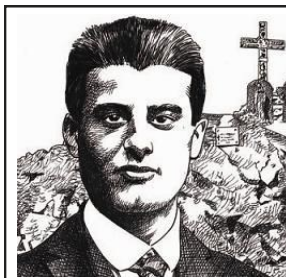

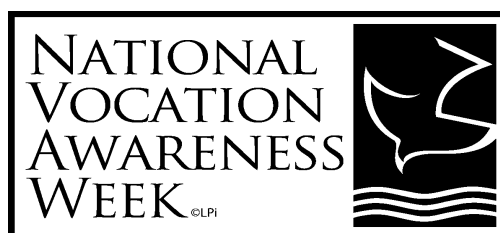

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents who wish to have a child baptized should contact Rev. Joseph Giroux to make arrangements for the date and for a program of preparation. Parents are highly encouraged to make arrangements at least three months before the child is born, as the Catholic Church encourages Baptism for infants as soon as possible after birth. Adults and older children (seven years or older) interested in Baptism or entering into full communion with the Catholic Church should inquire about the program of preparation (R.C.I.A.: the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults).

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

A Catholic wishing to be married in one of our churches should contact one of the priests at least six months prior to the desired date in order to begin making arrangements. A program of preparation is required. The parish should be contacted before any other plans are made—for example, the wedding reception.

SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK

For those preparing for surgery, nursing home residents, or the homebound, contact one of the parish priests to make arrangements to be anointed. For those in the hospital (especially in the event of an emergency), ask the hospital staff to contact the priest on call.
