FROM FR. JOE...

I'm very happy to share the good news that we've hired a **new Director of Christian Formation** for St. André's Parish. Her name is Catherine Suprenant, and she's a recent graduate of Benedictine College in Atchison, Kansas. She comes to us with an impressive resume, fine training, and great recommendations. Even though she was born and raised in Kansas, her last name does betray that she has roots which extend north of the border—in fact, she recently learned that her family is distantly related to none other than our own St. André Bessette. I have every confidence she'll do a fine job helping our young people grow in their Catholic faith. Catherine will begin on August 1.

Due to Confirmation, there will be **no Holy Hour with Confessions this coming Thursday, June 2**. We are, however, hosting the **World Meeting of Families "Family Mission Day" on Friday, June 3**. With Adoration throughout the afternoon and a special Holy Hour in the evening, I hope many of you will take advantage of this opportunity to celebrate the feast of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus during the Year of Mercy.

Some of you have been wondering (and rightly so) about the bottom line for the parish's **purchase and demolition of the former Malone Adult Center**. With all the bills now in, I can share with you the final figures. We purchased the building in October for \$50,000.00. The asbestos abatement (along with all necessary testing) cost \$132,638.00 (which is more than twice the cost estimated at the start of the project). There were \$8,666.40 in costs associated with demolition (such as fees at the landfill and the purchase of top soil for the lot), which was quite a bargain thanks to the extraordinarily generous contribution of equipment and labor from the local municipalities. There were \$9,612.81 in "other" expenses (such as heat, water, electricity, and closing costs). That comes to a grand total of \$200,917.21, which leaves St. André's with \$422,163.45 currently in savings. It's certainly more than we hoped to spend when we began this process, but I still think it's a wise investment with an eye toward the future. Now we just need a little rain to get the grass to grow...

MEMORIAL DAY MASS


A friendly note that the Mass on Monday, May 30th will be 9:00am at Notre Dame Church. There will be no 12:05pm Mass on that day.

(St. Joseph, St. John Bosco, Notre Dame, St. Helen)**

We are grateful that so many of you will visit one or more of our cemeteries this weekend. While we give special reverence for those who have served our country, visiting and praying for the dead is an invaluable work of mercy. You may wish to use the following prayer:

PRAYER AT THE GRAVESIDE

Lord, Jesus Christ, by your own three days in the tomb, you hallowed the graves of all who believe in you and so made the grave a sign of hope that promises resurrection even as it claims our mortal bodies. Grant that our brothers and sisters may sleep here in peace until you awake them to your glory, for you are the resurrection and the life. Then they will see you face to face and in your light will see light and know the splendor of God, for you live and reign forever and ever. Amen

We want to remind everyone of the importance of following the rules and regulations at our cemeteries:

FENCES, LAWN BORDERS, ORNAMENTS, STATUES, GLASS ARTICLES, SHRUBS, OR BUSHES ARE NOT ALLOWED.

Annual flowers are allowed to be placed adjacent to the stone. Artificial flowers are only allowed for two weeks prior and for two weeks after Memorial Day. They will be removed after that time. If you have any questions, please contact the office at 483-1300 during the hours of 9am to 4pm. The cemetery organization is not responsible for any lost or stolen items. Families of grave owners should be considerate of others. We ask that you not drive on the lawns. With the cooperation of all, each cemetery will continue to be a beautiful memorial to our deceased loved ones. Thank you for your cooperation!


