FROM FR. JOE...

No doubt, many of you were surprised to see **Monday's lead headline in the *Telegram***, "Bellmont officials eye former Owls Head church as possible community center" (in reference to St. Joseph's). I was surprised by it, too! As I've shared with you before, we've begun the process to (1) formally close the church (which hasn't been used for Mass in almost 10 years) and then (2) sell the property—doing the very same things at the same time for St. Mary's in Lake Titus. The paperwork for the first phase of the process is still in the works. (I will have it in to the Diocese in a week or so and then, following Canon Law, Bishop must consult about it with his Council of Priests—which does not meet again until September 28.) No moves can or will be made to sell either property until the buildings are first officially "closed" as churches and all sacred articles are removed. That being said, the Town of Bellmont has previously expressed serious interest in St. Joseph's in Owls Head for the reasons stated in the newspaper. It's the only serious offer that's been made so far, and—I must say—it sounds like a good one to me. It keeps the structure in respectful use for the benefit of the community, and it would be purchased by an entity with the means to maintain it properly. (For your information: I've also had two interested parties approach me about buying the church building in Lake Titus.) So, what do you think? I've received no objections to moving forward with the sale of these two oratories. If anybody has a concern about this proposed future use, please let me know.

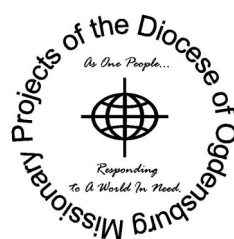

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents who wish to have a child baptized should contact Rev. Joseph Giroux to make arrangements for the date and for a program of preparation. Parents are highly encouraged to make arrangements at least three months before the child is born, as the Catholic Church encourages Baptism for infants as soon as possible after birth. Adults and older children (seven years or older) interested in Baptism or entering into full communion with the Catholic Church should inquire about the program of preparation (R.C.I.A.: the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults).

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

A Catholic wishing to be married in one of our churches should contact one of the priests at least six months prior to the desired date in order to begin making arrangements. A program of preparation is required. The parish should be contacted before any other plans are made—for example, the wedding reception.

SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK

For those preparing for surgery, nursing home residents, or the homebound, contact one of the parish priests to make arrangements to be anointed. For those in the hospital (especially in the event of an emergency), ask the hospital staff to contact the priest on call.
