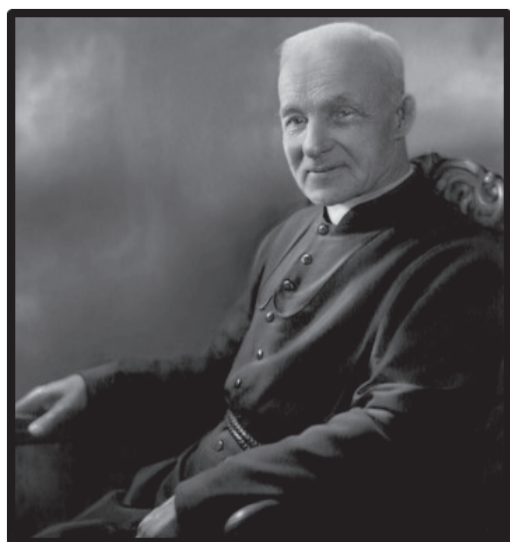

As part of the Parish Mission, we are **extending our usual time of Eucharistic Adoration at St. Joseph's next Tuesday**. Instead of concluding as usual at 1:00pm, it will continue into the evening. We have folks who regularly volunteer to spend some time with the Blessed Sacrament on Tuesdays, but we need some additional volunteers from 1:00pm until 7:00pm. If you're willing and able to take an hour of adoration, please call the office in the next few days (483-1300), tell us when you're available, and we'll put your name on the list.

**Fr. Scott will be away this week on his annual retreat.** Please be sure to keep him in your prayers in a particular way during these days of rest and renewal.

As I mentioned a couple of weeks ago, **I will be away Monday and Tuesday evenings this week** to do a pair of presentations on the Luminous Mysteries of the Rosary in the parishes in Redford and Dannemora, at the request of Fr. Mickey Demo. Thanks to all who came out to hear them when I gave them last Monday and Tuesday here in Malone!

**SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM**

Parents who wish to have a child baptized should contact Rev. Joseph Giroux to make arrangements for the date and for a program of preparation. Parents are highly encouraged to make arrangements at least three months before the child is born, as the Catholic Church encourages Baptism for infants as soon as possible after birth. Adults and older children (seven years or older) interested in Baptism or entering into full communion with the Catholic Church should inquire about the program of preparation (R.C.I.A.: the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults).

**SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY**

A Catholic wishing to be married in one of our churches should contact one of the priests at least six months prior to the desired date in order to begin making arrangements. A program of preparation is required. The parish should be contacted before any other plans are made—for example, the wedding reception.

**SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK**

For those preparing for surgery, nursing home residents, or the homebound, contact one of the parish priests to make arrangements to be anointed. For those in the hospital (especially in the event of an emergency), ask the hospital staff to contact the priest on call.
