**From Fr. Joe...**

I'm **concluding my annual retreat**, and will be returning to Malone on Sunday evening. Thanks so much for your prayers this week!

This Monday we're having our **Listening Session** concerning the Proposed Pastoral Plan for St. André's. I hope you've had a chance to read and pray about the Plan since we mailed it to you earlier this week. (If you aren't on our mailing list and didn't receive a copy in the mail, there are copies available in each of our churches and it can also be accessed on the parish website.) Blessed John Henry Newman once wrote, "In a higher world it is otherwise, but here below to live is to change, and to be perfect is to have changed often." No, change is never easy—but, if we're honest about it, we must admit that things only stop changing when they've died. The Pastoral Council has put a lot of thought and prayer into this Pastoral Plan, looking at the big picture and the long haul in an effort to be sure that St. André's Parish doesn't just survive for awhile, but is able to thrive and be vital for generations to come. We need your input to continue toward this critical goal. I hope many of you will come and take part on Monday.

On Sunday evening of our recent Parish Mission with Fr. Tom Higman, we had a **Praise and Worship Holy Hour** that was pretty well attended and very well received. I'm happy to share that we're going to make it a regular part of our parish schedule. On the first Friday of the each month, we're planning something called **Hearts on Fire**. The evening will begin with a Holy Hour at 7:00pm, which will be followed by a bonfire, a few snacks, and some time for fellowship. Joey Izzo (a gifted musician from Lake Placid who has been on the staff at Camp Guggenheim for several years) has agreed to come and lead the music for the Holy Hour. The first one will be Friday, December 2, at Notre Dame. All are welcome!

**SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM**

Parents who wish to have a child baptized should contact Rev. Joseph Giroux to make arrangements for the date and for a program of preparation. Parents are highly encouraged to make arrangements at least three months before the child is born, as the Catholic Church encourages Baptism for infants as soon as possible after birth. Adults and older children (seven years or older) interested in Baptism or entering into full communion with the Catholic Church should inquire about the program of preparation (R.C.I.A.: the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults).

**SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY**

A Catholic wishing to be married in one of our churches should contact one of the priests at least six months prior to the desired date in order to begin making arrangements. A program of preparation is required. The parish should be contacted before any other plans are made—for example, the wedding reception.

**SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK**

For those preparing for surgery, nursing home residents, or the homebound, contact one of the parish priests to make arrangements to be anointed. For those in the hospital (especially in the event of an emergency), ask the hospital staff to contact the priest on call.
