FROM THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE....



THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT: “Rejoice! Again it is said, Rejoice!” These are the words that accompany this Sunday of Advent. A helpful reminder, wouldn’t you say? We have a lot to rejoice about and be grateful for as we light the rose candle of our Advent Wreath and contemplate the joy that is our life. As I mentioned in my homily last weekend, our job, our ministry, our life has to show this “Good News” – this Gospel and make our face, actions and entire body reflect the joy which is ours in Christ. We have been saved --- let’s show it!

STRATEGIC PLAN: Last week our special ad hoc committee got together at the chair’s house (thank you Sharon Martin!) to celebrate the 11-months of work. Over the next five years, we will point out to you how we are living our strategic plan. In a few weeks, the Pastoral Council will approve and implement the goals, strategies and action steps. We want this to begin on the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord 2015 – so that by 2020 we will look back and say, “Wow – look at how the Roman Catholic Community of Saint Paschal Baylon grew!” Thanks for your prayers and support of the project. We will always share info about the plan here and, when implemented, the entire report will be on our website.

YOUTH INVOLVEMENT: A key component of our Strategic Plan is youth involvement. I am inviting some of our students from our school and PSR to be regularly assigned lectors. They have always been welcome, once they make their First Communion --- so parents, thank you for supporting your children in this ministry.

We have other “hidden gems” in our parish! Due to the fact that we are creatures of habit, you may not know what is happening at other Masses in the parish. I love highlighting a few things about our Masses, especially when it comes to youth and young families:

- **4:30 Mass** always has a full cry room with our young families
- **4:30 Mass** has a Sister of Notre Dame playing the violin with our combo choir of trained musicians and young parents
- **8:00 Mass** is having young families in the cry room again!
- **10:00 Mass** has the Children’s Liturgy of the Word where those who haven’t made their First Communion (about 50 children) experience the Liturgy of the Word with the Children’s Lectionary – sharing God’s Word on their own celebrating that processes in the Family Life Center
- **Noon Mass** has our Young Adult Choir and group. The “Nooners” also are a Young Adult group, singles, newly married couples and anyone who enjoys fun, to hang out for different events, especially game night!
- **7:00 Mass** has the Teen Choir and Youth Ministry focus, helping with ushering, music, lecturing and high school teens may be Communion Ministers

Rejoice! Our youth are part of our parish’s life – and we strongly encourage increased participation and sharing of your many gifts!
