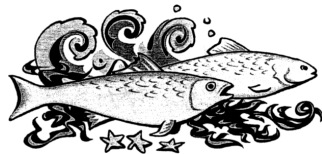

SAINT PASCHAL TRAVELERS



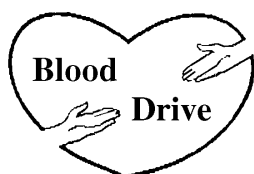

LENT REMINDERS

Q: How has tithing been over the years of your pastorate? Some think that it has gone down and people are not giving as much.

A: The Finance Council and Business Manager did a study to see how our November, December and January collections (just the first collection and Christmas) have been over the years since 2009, just to do a sampling to answer this question. Here are the results:

- 2009: \$291,000
- 2010: \$307,000
- 2011: \$313,000
- 2012: \$332,000
- 2013: \$314,000
- 2014 \$332,000
- 2015: \$382,000 – Grateful Giving Started in November

FROM THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE



2nd Sunday of Lent: We celebrate the Transfiguration and a key element of being a Christian disciple. This is an element we take for granted, and we should not, for as we know, if we assume.... We take for granted "listening!" In today's Gospel, Mark adds these sacred words that were not said at Christ's baptism: "This is my beloved Son; listen to him." God realizes that the personal encounter of Christ at baptism is not an encounter that all the disciples need to hear. And half way through the Gospel, just like half way through our lives, we need to hear better and hear one another. But first – attune better to Christ in our lives!

Prayers for the Homebound and This Ministry: We are blessed to have a wonderful team of Communion Ministers to go to the homebound to share the Eucharist. They share hospitality, God's Word, a bulletin and words of love and care. If you would like to share Holy Communion with a loved one who is not able to come to church, please let me know and I will help train you for this ministry.

Ministry of Fundraising: So many of our parish ministries work very hard to support our parish's life and our outreach to the poor and those in need, whether in our parish or those in NE Ohio. There is a lot to coordinating our fundraising and calendaring, to make sure that we are organized and do not compete or overlap in these endeavors. As part of our Strategic Pastoral Plan, we are having organization meeting for fundraising.
