In case you missed it, the Advent Lessons & Carols was a World Premiere Event here with all our music ministers leading us in a special prayer reflection on the latest papal encyclical *Our Common Home – Laudato Si* (Italian name of the document). Special thanks to everyone for their beautiful hard work on this masterpiece of scripture, encyclical and song. My special thanks to the Music Ministry for the tireless dedication, service and beautiful song!!!

***Blessing Our Houses:*** In the narthex are pieces of chalk that have been blessed for you to take home today and bless your home. Please see elsewhere in the bulletin the little prayer service that comes from the *Catholic Household Prayers & Blessings*.

***Planning for Summer:*** We are already thinking summer maintenance projects here at SPB. We are looking for two more cleaners – for evenings and weekends. Contact Roger Fisher, our Maintenance Supervisor, if you or someone you know is interested. We also plan on these workers helping with the summer projects.

The maintenance committee is already planning its work for the summer – from flooring replacements in the Eymard Room and classrooms, adding a concrete exit to the school by the former module building, replacing concrete on Blue Ribbon Way and hopefully during Spring Break, we will advance with replacement of the handicap entrance to the church. If you see or have questions, Roger’s email is in the bulletin.



There are “big ticket items” that we know we need to do – such as replacing the parking lots of the church (\$250,000 estimated bids), replacing Saint Paschal Lane (\$30,000), replacing Blue Ribbon Way and the Convent Drive (cost unknown at this time), adding a sidewalk for safety from Colony Drive, along Saint Paschal Lane to the church (cost unknown at this time), replacing the single pane windows of the church to double-pane glass (1 million dollars), upgrading the kitchen in Father O’Brien Hall (unknown at this point). These are items that currently the Finance Council and Pastoral Council are discerning. What is the best way to go about these repairs and replacements? Capital campaign? Individual fundraising? Share your thoughts and concerns as we begin to plan for 2016 and 2017. These are important items, important financial decisions and cares for the future of our parish’s life and our facilities. We have been blessed with excellent stewardship in our 63-year history. We will continue this great legacy and build on our excellent foundation!

In the meantime, let’s look forward to the many blessings of the year to come. Thanks for journeying together in faith at SPB! Let us continue to pray for each other!

## EPIPHANY BLESSING OF HOMES

**EPIPHANY BLESSING OF HOMES:** This year, our small group participants in “Arise,” (our several week program to deepen faith and get to know new parishioners), have provided a blessing of homes. Traditionally, Epiphany (in the USA Sunday, January 3, 2016) has been the day when we would bless our homes and write, with blessed chalk, above the door posts the year and “C + M + B.” I thank the small group leaders of Arise for gathering chalk and providing it in the narthex. Beginning the weekend of the Epiphany, you may write “20 + C + M + B + 16” on your door posts and use the following ritual as a family (adapted from the *Catholic Book of Household Blessings & Prayers*, second edition):

- Let us praise God, who fills our hearts and homes with peace. Blessed be God forever! (All respond: Blessed be God forever!)
- The Word became flesh and made his dwelling place among us. It is Christ who enlightens our hearts and homes with his love. May all who enter this home find Christ’s light and love.
- Read: Luke 19: 1 – 9 from the Bible.
- Intercessions: The Son of God made his home among us. With thanks and praise let us call upon him (response is “Stay with us, LORD”).
  - LORD Jesus Christ, with Mary and Joseph you formed the Holy Family: remain in our home, that we may know you as our guest and honor you as our Head. We pray: **Stay with us, LORD.**
  - LORD Jesus Christ, you had no place to lay your head, but in the spirit of poverty accepted the hospitality of your friends: grant that through our help the homeless may obtain proper housing. We pray: **Stay with us, LORD.**

## **EPIPHANY BLESSING OF HOMES – continued**

- LORD Jesus Christ, the three magi present their gifts to you in praise and adoration: grant that those living in this house may use their talents and abilities to your greater glory. We pray: **Stay with us, LORD.**
  - LORD Jesus Christ, you gave us our parish family of Saint Paschal Baylon, bless our pastor, pastoral staff, our Blessed Sacrament Community, Sisters of Notre Dame and all who build God's reign in our parish family. We pray: **Stay with us, LORD.**
  - LORD Jesus Christ, in this Year of Mercy, may we show the gift of compassion and care to others. We pray: **Stay with us, LORD.**
  - LORD Jesus Christ, we hope for more men and women to serve the church in religious life or in the ordained priesthood. Help us discern who will assist you in this special mission. We pray: **Stay with us, LORD.**
- BLESSING: LORD God of heaven and earth, you revealed your only-begotten Son to every nation by the guidance of a star. Bless this house and all who inhabit it. Fill us with the light of Christ that our concern for others may reflect your love. We ask this through Christ our LORD.
  - SIGNING WITH THE CROSS: May Christ Jesus dwell with us, keep us from all harm, and make us one in mind and heart, now and forever.
  - SING: "O Come All Ye Faithful" or another song.
  - WRITE & BLESS: 20 + C + M + B + 16 on door posts with blessed chalk from church narthex and use holy water from room to room to bless the home. Holy water may be taken from the baptismal font from church.
