The Diocese of Cleveland asked our ministry for a report on how many hot meals we serve to the needy and homeless. We serve 20,000 hot meals a year. Helping Hands is known to be the only ministry that provides hot meals all year. Our Caravan group of Helping Hands feeds Bethel Church and Four Corners Church once a month as well as providing clothing and other necessities. In the winter we feed at St. Malachi. Our Knight Riders go out every Wednesday night under bridges and other places to feed the needy and homeless as well as give food to St. Malachi's Hospice for aids patients. On the second Thursday of the month, we feed the homeless at St. Augustine and on the second Saturday we feed the homeless at St. Vitus. For the past six months we have been giving food and clothing to those in need at Villa Serena. This is all made possible through our wonderfully generous parishioners. Thank you and God bless.

FROM THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE



22nd Week in Ordinary Time:

Jesus tells two parables today in the readings to illustrate a point about hospitality and humbleness. We are to invite and host and remember that through our hospitality and humbleness we draw others closer to the face of God, the face of mercy. With so many people going out to dinner, we let others host and serve us. We are grateful for this reality and the wonderful people who do give us awesome service in restaurants. But when was the last time we gave a party or

hosted an event? We are never too old or tired to extend an invitation and to host a gathering. In these moments, we uplift others to see God's kindness through us. So, go ahead, have another meal event!

Special Picnic Thanks! We are grateful to the Knights of Columbus for sponsoring, hosting and serving us last week at our annual parish picnic. They are great BBQ leaders! Also, we are grateful to the Welcome Committee and Kay Vincent for putting together the special shopping bags with our parish logo and colors. What a way to be Paschal Proud and advertise our great parish in the community. Thank you to them and the Music Ministry, MOMS Group, Youth Group, the Margevicius & Silbiger families who helped organize different pieces to our annual parish event.

Religious Formation/Education Back in Swing: Now that our day school is back in the swing of things, it's time to think about PSR for our first through 8th graders and the small group, faith sharing groups that ARISE puts together for us. Let us recall that our Pastoral Plan asked us to gather in small groups to get to know parishioners and increase our faith. ARISE is a wonderful opportunity for either meeting folks during the day or at night, once a week for six sessions. We meet here or if one or two groups is willing, in a parishioner home. We each are called to deepen and continue our life-long formation as a disciple of Christ. How wonderful that our Spiritual Formation Committee keeps us engaged through the task and fulfillment of our Pastoral Plan. Sign up this weekend in the Fickel Narthex (south central one).

Join us for an hour of prayer: One of the charges of the Pastoral Plan was to have different liturgical services of prayer and increase praying in our parish – you know, fewer meetings and organizing and just “experiencing” and resting in the LORD. The US Bishops are calling upon all churches to have September 9 as a special day of prayer for the end of racial tensions in our country, increasing harmony peace in neighborhoods and growing in sharing the love of Christ to our neighbors. In preparation for this, our Taizé Prayer this Wednesday night will focus in this way. **Please join us at 7:00 p.m.** For those of you unfamiliar with the Taizé style,” think of the songs you already know – “Jesus Remember Me” or “Eat This Bread.” Their refrains repeat, like mantras of repetitive prayer in the style of the rosary and the “Hail Mary.” The beauty of this style is that while we are singing and praying, we get lost in our thoughts and prayers while the sound is echoing around us. It deepens our attention to the Holy Spirit's promptings in our life. Because we are a “Blessed

Sacrament Community parish,” we organize this prayer in the setting of exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, with some scripture readings and lots of moments of silence.

I hope you will come and try this style of prayer – and you’ll also enjoy fulfilling one of our Pastoral Plan goals to broaden your prayer life.

Community at Prayer Ministry (Adoration): We thank Jenn Bartlett for leading this ministry and the many who pray in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament in our parish and around the Hillcrest area. Due to her work schedule, she is unable to continue. I am looking for some more helpers to aid in this ministry. The leader of this ministry send notices to our pray-ers, develops a calendar/schedule, insures that the hours after morning Mass until 11:00 p.m. are “covered,” and is a resource for the email list and information.
