SEPTEMBER 9 – NATIONAL DAY OF PRAYER

In the wake of racial tensions and tragic moments within some of our communities, Archbishop Kurtz has called for a National Day of Prayer on September 9, the feast of St. Peter Claver. He hopes that this will be one way to “nurture open, honest and civil dialogue in our communities struggling with violence in many forms” (letter from Archbishop Wilton Gregory to the Bishops of the United States, dated August 11, 2016). In addition, he has announced the formation of a special Task Force to promote peace and unity.
