19th Sunday in Ordinary Time: We are back to an “ordinary” Sunday after three weeks focusing other important mysteries in our church calendar and life. And is it just me or are you noticing a pattern? Today’s readings, but especially the Gospel are inviting us to “take courage, do not be afraid and to be saved.” Perhaps with some of the personal realities going on for us, these readings come as a welcome relief and an opportunity for us to recall that there is no need “for little faith or doubt.” For others it may be an opportunity for great faith statements such as, “Truly you are the Son of God.” Wherever we are

on the “faith spectrum” there is something in today’s Gospel for us to relate to and take to heart. From mountain praying to rocky seas, we have all had these moments and something in between. In between it all, Jesus reaches out to us and takes our hand, holding us up so that we have nothing to fear.

Our Ministry serves a number of places and in the next few bulletins I will share with you the places we serve. If anyone would like to go volunteer at these places, we would be very happy to have you. One of the places is Greater Bethel AME Church in the Collinwood area, at 14735 Thomas Ave., off East 152nd St. The volunteers meet at St. Paschal on the third Saturday of the month all year round. The group usually consists of 5 to 7 volunteers who meet at the Parish Life Center kitchen at 1:15 p.m. and return around 5:15 p.m. This is an outdoor venue. The attendees are low income neighborhood residents who are picking up Food Bank groceries starting at 2:00 p.m. Our volunteers set up and provide a warm meal for approximately 120 people. We also set up an area of clothing to pick up for those in need.

We pray that God will help us to act in a way that results in the good for all and that He will show us that we too are poor and hungry, feeble and needy in so many ways, and help us recognize that our giving can only spring from what we have already been given.
