## FROM THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE



**20<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time:** This is a great healing story in the Gospel of Matthew. Why this moment in the Gospel is so fascinating is because we see and experience Jesus as a human being at a threshold moment: he has been only ministering to his people and is now being called to serve foreigners. The Canaanite woman helps him come to an understanding and speaks to him in bold terms to learn his purpose and assist the woman in getting her wish. It's a wonderful relationship, and one that challenges us in our own day and time. Aren't we now in a time in our society and our own life where we sometimes are challenged by "different

than us" folks who ask us questions, make us think and need our love, support and care? Are we open to this growth within our own lives?

Paul, in the letter to the Romans, mentions how he is making his "own race jealous" because he is being faithful and obedient to God. God shows mercy to all—may we do the same as we grow in ourselves, just as Jesus did, to be faithful in serving the needs of all.

**Construction Update:** It would be safe to say that we are all disappointed that the rain, the discovery of a water spring and broken equipment delayed the timely completion of our reconstruction of Saint Paschal Lane. We all know, hope and pray that construction projects will be started and completed on time. Stuff happens! And, I am so grateful that you have been patient, kind and hopeful about the project's completion SOON! Thanks for continuing to adapt and hope that we will be back to our normal driving on campus by the end of the month.

**When SPB Lane is Open....** Please note that when SPB Lane returns, it will not only be different due to the concrete, but there will be new road lines directing you into a passing lane by the Southeast (Handicap Door) Narthex. We will have a new drop off lane, closer to the door. This will allow for cars to pass on the left. This is made possible due to the removal of that old concrete divider. Secondly, there will be additional handicap parking. Notice the new lines and area that was made possible by removing islands, leveling the parking lot and putting in new drainage. There will now be a sidewalk on the north rim of SPB Lane. This is one reason why the project took an extra amount of time – making sure the new grades and new features were completed appropriately.

We appreciate your generous gifts to make this possible during the emergency of the sinking lane. Discovering the underground water spring helped us understand why we have been having the sinkhole effect.

**School Starts Tuesday!** We are getting back to normal around SPB with the regular meetings and events that make our campus hum with ministry, excitement and collaboration! We are looking forward to welcoming the students back full time Tuesday, with the Opening Mass of the Holy Spirit on Wednesday. Each year we have a special theme – and sometimes with a song. This year we have both for it will be: We Will Walk with God (in our *Gather* hymnal). You'll hear the song also at weekend Masses, PSR liturgies and more.

**Looking Ahead:** Besides our theme and song for the education year, we will have a few other things coming up that get us in the spirit of “building the reign of God” in our parish and community. These are things we have become

accustomed to doing, but we should recall, they are part of the fabric of our parish’s life and need your support, prayers and participation on many levels. We look forward to so much each Fall. In the parish’s life, this profit is wonderful news, especially since for the first time in 8 years our tithing was actually slightly down \$200,000. We worked hard on cutting expenses as a Pastoral Staff and we appreciate all that you donate to make our parish work so well. It takes a lot of tithing, volunteering and fundraising to help our over 3 million dollar campus run well. We are filled with gratitude!

This ceremony follows the tradition of Robert Baden Powell (the founder of Boy Scouts) and allows these young men to provide a service to their parish community. This is a solemn and reverent ceremony - giving honor to our Flags that have flown through the years. If you have a flag to be retired, you are welcome to bring it.



Some information about what to expect:

The Ceremony will begin with a few words about why and how flags are to be retired, and then the Scouts will begin to retire flags. The custom is to burn the flags in reverent silence. Ashes from previous retirements going back to Robert Baden Powell are added to the fire to signify the long lineage of Scouting and Reverence shown by Scouts. Before the flags are placed in the fire, the field of stars is separated from the stripes. The field of stars is never cut to signify the unity of our 50 states. The remains of the flag are then placed on the fire. After all flags have been disposed, the cooled ashes are then collected and some of the ashes are stored until the next ceremony to continue the tradition.
