ARISE. The St Clare/St Paschal Spiritual Formation Committee is pleased to announce that we will offer **ARISE Together in Christ, Season 5** beginning the week of September 17. Each Season has its own set of topics for discussion. So Season 5 has all brand new topics! Our first 4 seasons were great successes, and we are looking forward to continuing to grow in our faith and strengthen our bonds with like-minded people. This weekend, we rejoiced that after seven years on the streets, one of the people we help named Dave, has moved into an apartment. He tells of the days when he never knew where his next meal would come from. He also tells of the very cold winters and wondered if he would be found frozen to death. When our volunteers went to see Dave at his new apartment, he hugged everyone and tears were shed by everyone, not only Dave. We never gave up on him. Many times we would see him very depressed and we prayed that he would not take his life. He is a new man because of prayers and weekly visits by the Knight Riders. Dave said that the only hope he had was the hope that came from the parishioners at Saint Paschal parish. He thanks God for our parish, and he believes our parish helped give him this new life. This story about David is not the first one of its kind. Since we have been going out on Wednesday evenings, we have helped in taking 28 men and women off the streets to begin a new life. This only happens because of the prayers, food, clothing and financial help from the parish. So, we all rejoice when, by the grace of God, a person has been restored to new life. God bless you all and thank you! GOD IS GOOD ALL THE TIME. ALL THE TIME GOD IS GOOD.

KINDERGARTEN PSR PROGRAM FOR 2017-2018 YEAR: We are expanding our PSR program for the 2017-2018 school year to include kindergarten. Registration forms are available in the Parish Office and online at <http://psr.saintpaschal.com> (click on "Registration Form" on the left sidebar.)

TIME AND DURATION CHANGE FOR 2017-2018 PSR YEAR: In order to accommodate our new kindergarten PSR students, **in the 2017-2018 school year, PSR will meet from 6:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.** Please note the earlier start time as well as the new hour time length.

REGISTRATION: Forms will be available from the Parish Office and on <http://psr.saintpaschal.com> (click on "Registration Form" on the left sidebar.) **For an early tuition rate, register before August 1st.** Early tuition rates for this year are \$85 for 1 child, \$155 for 2 children, and \$230 for 3 or more children. **Scholarships are available.** Additionally, our registration form also serves as the emergency medical form as well as the media release form for your convenience. **Special note:** Two years of sacramental preparation is required. If you have a child entering 1st grade or 7th grade and are interested in them receiving their sacraments in 2nd and 8th grades the following year, please make sure to enroll them in PSR for this coming school year.

SPB CUB SCOUT PACK 555 will have a solemn Flag Retirement ceremony on Saturday September 9th at 7:30 p.m. in the church's main parking lot; the parishioners of SPB are invited to attend. This ceremony follows the tradition of Robert Baden Powell (the founder of Boy Scouts) and allows these young men to provide a service to their parish community. This is a solemn and reverent ceremony - giving honor to our flags that have flown through the years. If you have a flag to be retired, you are welcome to bring it.

Some information about what to expect:

The Ceremony will begin with a few words about why and how flags are to be retired, and then the Scouts will begin to retire flags. The custom is to burn the flags in reverent silence. Ashes from previous retirements going back to Robert Baden Powell are added to the fire to signify the long lineage of Scouting and Reverence shown by Scouts. Before the flags are placed in the fire, the field of stars is separated from the stripes. The field of stars is never cut to signify the unity of our 50 states. The remains of the flag are then placed on the fire.

After all flags have been disposed, the cooled ashes are then collected and some of the ashes are stored until the next ceremony to continue the tradition.
