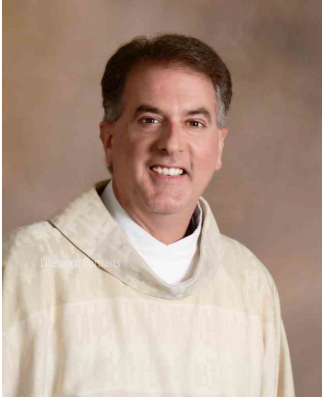

26th Week in Ordinary Time – Respect Life Month

Begins: Today's readings remind us how we are to choose how to live and respect our life and the life of others. We are merely stewards, entrusted with the gifts and talents that God gave us; Co-creators with God to insure a path of goodness and justice. There are people who do not make the correct choices for themselves or their child/ren. We hope and pray, like in the Gospel, they have a change of heart and turn their heart always toward God.

In our world today we are confronted with a lot of "individual" choices or people that feel that their rights are the only rights. Communal, or society choices don't seem to be of much concern. Pope Francis has reawakened the conversation about making the good choices for all parts of life, from conception to natural death, as a way to remember that we are part of the Body of Christ, Saint Paul's theology, and we are interconnected, whether we like it or not. We pray for people to always choose life, to choose the good for the common good. We pray for minds to change in the conversation about life issues – to allow all children to be born, to allow God to choose when a person is to be taken to eternal life, to hope that all will be treated with dignity and respect, whether in prison or the person trying to find sanctuary in a new country. We may not agree on the approach, but we hopefully all agree that we are all God's people. And as Saint Paul reminds us in the letter to the Philippians today, "Do nothing out of selfishness." And, "[let us be] in the same mind, with the same love, united in heart, thinking one thing:" Let us glorify God – and therefore respect God in one another!
