FROM THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE



27th Sunday in Ordinary Time: Jesus gives us a very serious parable today. As *Give Us This Day* editor Mary Stommes says in her column, “If you disrespect the Son of God and neglect the Kingdom of love [God] entrusts to you, it’s seriously serious.” When we reject humans, when we disrespect all human life in any form, we disrespect God and the fruits of God in our world. Serious stuff for us to ponder as we remember our role in building God’s reign here on earth – and respecting all human life and the care of our planet for other humans to enjoy!

Blessing of Health Care Workers: We are blessed to have so many people in our parish who work in the health care field. We live in Medical City USA – nowhere on earth do you have such excellent health care – four great chains! We are blessed – and we want to help those in the field continue the mission of caring and curing. In honor of Saint Luke, the patron of health care, we will have our annual blessing after the homily next weekend at all the Masses.

Anointing of the Sick on Saint Luke Day – Wednesday, October 18: Another tradition we keep holy is celebrating the sacrament of the sick on Saint Luke’s feast day. After the homily, we will celebrate this other sacrament in the context of Mass.

Looking to the Poor: We have all been struck by the terrible weather-related tragedies in our country, but especially in the Caribbean. The island countries have been devastated. On Sunday, we had the blessing of pets and the love the pet owners have for their pets was obvious. I was then blessed to be a part of the Rally for Life in front of our Church to remind people that all life is special and that love of those in need is the love of God indeed.
