FROM THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE



1st Sunday of Lent: We hear the shortest version of Jesus' temptation in the desert. No conversations with the devil; no walking around and reporting on many items that tempted Christ. Isn't that how our own temptations are? They are already built in to us - no words are necessary. However, John the Baptist echoes the words that we need to hear to help us get through our temptations: "The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent and believe in the gospel." These same words were used on Ash Wednesday to call us into the period of Lent, a time of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. A time to

help us with our temptations and remind us that God is always here and our time is fulfilled with God alone.

Through our Art & Environment Committee, Jeff Loerch has assisted us again with a beautiful banner that I hope you will watch week to week and notice how it transforms. Like the scriptures, we are rooted in Christ, but this season "uproots us" and changes us. May it be fruitful as we work together to help others see that the kingdom of God is here and at hand!

Catholic Charities Appeal: Our own diocese can be so proud of what we do in this outreaching ministry serving at least 400,000 people a year with 150 services at 60 locations across 8 counties.
