## FROM THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE



**6<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter:** Today is a regular Sunday when we focus on love. Of course, each Sunday we focus on the gift of love and the gift of Eucharist, Christ's ultimate example of loving. From today's Gospel, we are reminded from Jesus' final discourse, after washing the feet of the disciples, that this is how we remain in love, follow the commandments and continue to serve one another. Loving is a verb, just like Eucharist, in tandem to continually practice.

How wonderful that this weekend we celebrate First Communion, in the midst of this great sacrament of love, in a community practicing loving and serving God well! Last Sunday we heard how we are part of the vine, being pruned, growing to bear fruit. Let us practice and see very real ways that God has chosen us to be his loving servants. Let us make our Eucharist authentic – truly bearing fruit by loving and serving, especially the least among us!

**Primary Election This Tuesday!** As you know, our Social Action Commission (SAC) has been keeping us in the loop on very important issues that affect us and our Gospel living. This week, we have a primary election – and like every vote – we are so blessed to have this privilege and opportunity. The Catholic Bishops of our State regularly help us form our conscience with voter information. We are all called to be active participants as citizens and allow our Gospel and moral choices to direct our decisions. Again, for this election Tuesday, the bishops and our SAC ask us to be informed on the issues and be aware that they support State Issue 1 to help redistrict our state with a public process for drawing Ohio's legislative districts. Additionally, the Catholic Conference of Ohio proposes the following reflection questions for future choosing of political candidates:

1. What is the candidate's commitment to protect all human life, from conception to natural death?
2. What is the candidate's commitment to other serious threats to human life and dignity such as racism and other unjust discrimination, the use of the death penalty, resorting to unjust war, the use of torture, war crimes, the failure to respond to those who are suffering from hunger or a lack of health care, or an unjust immigration policy?
3. How does the candidate measure up in both words and actions with the totality of Catholic Social Teaching?
4. What would be morally grave reasons to support and/or oppose a candidate? (Please refer to the U.S. Bishops document [Forming Consciences for Faithful Citizenship, paragraphs 34 through 37](#)).
5. What is my assessment of the candidate's personal integrity, governing philosophy, performance and ability to influence a given issue?
6. Has the candidate demonstrated sufficient competency to hold such an elected position?

Our bishop is quite inspirational and enjoys his time wherever he goes in the diocese, but especially meeting the parishioners of the diocese. I want to thank the team that help put this great liturgy together: Tony Ward, Anna & George Peko, Jeff Cornelius, our 8<sup>th</sup> grade catechists, our great team of ushers, altar servers and communion ministers, and the Ladies Guild and seventh grade parents who hosted the reception.

It's been fun going around town and having folks tell me how much they appreciate all the hard work that goes in to our festival.
