## FROM THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE



**The Ascension of the LORD:** Happy Ascension & Happy Mother's Day! Our second reading today helps us recognize how these two great feasts have so much in common. First, our mothers usually make sure we "go," and live the Gospel. They make sure we are baptized; they make sure we learn and know the faith, and not always by "book learning" but by living the faith. But more importantly, as the letter to the Ephesians puts it: God puts our mothers, as agents of Christ, to "fill all things in every way." This is so that "we may know what is the hope that belongs to [our] call." Mothers help us in our vocations to be true disciples and Christians. They point the way, just as Christ pointed the way – to go and live the faith. May we keep up this great tradition of sharing and living the faith, pointing to the risen Christ.

**Forward in Faith Hope & Love:** It has been some time since we had an appeal to invite you to pray and think about your tithing to SPB, our home church. Thank you for taking the time to read the letter I mailed to your home. (If you didn't receive it, please check with the front office.)
