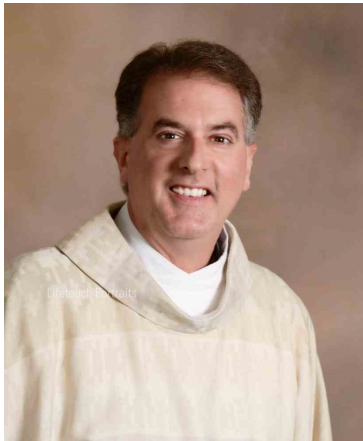

## FROM FATHER LANE, SSS, OUR 8<sup>TH</sup> PASTOR:



### 32<sup>nd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time:

“Contributing all she had!” This is the summation of the story of the poor widow, who by her witness demonstrated her willingness to give God the glory through her livelihood. It’s important for us to recall that all we have is a gift – all comes from God. She knew this, and that God would always care and provide for her. She trusted. We are also being reminded of our trust and call to stewardship – giving of our time, talent and treasure to the God who has blessed us.

**Lectors Needed:** It’s time for our fall recruitment drive and I wish to focus on the ministry of lector. We are blessed with many great lectors who proclaim God’s word to us in wonderful ways. Each of our lector teams (five of them) needs at least one or more new lectors. We love it when families proclaim together and we are looking especially for lectors who are in 5 through 12<sup>th</sup> grade.
