

## FROM FATHER LANE, SSS, OUR 8<sup>TH</sup> PASTOR:



**4<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time:** Today's readings emphasize again the importance of listening to the Living Word of God, acting upon it and allowing ourselves to let God's Word touch our lives to put it into practice. How do we do this? Paul's letter to the Corinthians gives us the important context of putting God's Word into practice: by loving! We hear again the famous reading, shared at many weddings, the active verb of LOVE. Love shows itself in our lives when we are patient, kind, not jealous, truthful, hoping for the best, not wanting others to fail.

It's the guidepost of actively living out our faith and remaining in that love throughout the course of our vocation as a disciple of Christ and a caring partner with God. Who needs a bit of God's Word in our lives today? How can I be more loving and living God's Word in this very concrete way? We are so loved by God that we cannot help but be overwhelmed by it to love others in return!

**New groups:** The Holy Spirit is inspiring new leaders to come forward at SPB in specific ways of building communion. I am grateful to my mom, Jo Ann Lane, for working with the Turkish American Community, our interfaith connection, to add a cooking group to our parish. As you have noticed elsewhere in the bulletin, there is a schedule of where we will share one another's cultures and recipes. The second new group is the Anxiety Support Group, beginning tomorrow, Monday, led by Nick Carlone. Through prayer, sharing, support and suggestions, we hope that this will be like other support groups, offering an opportunity for people to be in communion with the suffering, support and renewal in their lives. Lastly, a Christian Writer's Fellowship will be starting soon with the leadership of Joe McCormack. This will be a time to explore great writers in our tradition and other great writers who are present in our parish, sharing a communion of talent through the gift of the pen and keyboard. We'll keep you posted on these developments. And as always, the Pastoral Staff and Pastoral Council appreciate the ways the leaders want our parish to nurture one another's faith.

**2020 Pastoral Plan:** During our 2020 Pastoral Plan meetings this year, we will be evaluating our recent plan, our parish organizations and ministries and developing new goals for the next five years. Our ad-hoc committee, led by our Pastoral Council chair Jeff Gueulette and our Advancement Director (a goal of the last pastoral plan) Kelly Ericsson will be contacting folks who are not part of the committee for input, evaluation and suggestions for our parish's future growth.

**Filling the Church for Tetelestai:** We have a wonderful chance to begin the Lenten season by sharing in the production of the musical play "Tetelestai." (This is the Greek word that means, "It is Finished," the last words of Christ on the cross.) Please invite everyone to be part of this ecumenical passion play/musical, sharing the last week of Christ's life and his resurrection from the dead. Open for all ages, and free, Friday, March 1 & Saturday, March 2 at 8:00 p.m. Sunday, March 3 there is a matinee at 2:00 p.m. The production takes place in church around the sanctuary (and **not** on the altar – so during the week of the performances, you will see the stage in the sanctuary). The production is free, but there will be a free-will offering taken to defray the costs of the musical. A reception will follow after each performance in the Fickel Narthex, with a chance to meet the cast. Our youth and students in the school and PSR will also be pen

pals with cast members, learning about the history of each character in the passion narrative. Please welcome your neighbors, family members and friends to join us these three days! More info and posters to come!

**Next Weekend Begins Catholic Charities - Walk in Faith. Give in Joy:** The 2019 Catholic Charities Annual Appeal kicks off a January mailing with the theme “Walk in Faith. Give in Joy.” During the week of 14 January, close to 100,000 households received a letter from Bishop Perez seeking support for the Annual Appeal and asking each of us, “What does it mean to walk in faith and give in joy?” Because of the enduring generosity of donors, Catholic Charities is able to continue to show Christ’s mercy to people who may otherwise be forgotten or discarded. Due to the increasing number of those in need of assistance, the Appeal Goal for 2019 is \$13.5 million; an increase of \$1 million dollars. Together let us extend the hand of mercy to others.
