FROM FATHER LANE, SSS, OUR 8TH PASTOR:



7th Sunday in Ordinary Time: This week's gospel continues where we left off last week in Luke – with the Sermon on the Plain. Very similar to Matthew's Gospel, Luke continues Jesus' teachings about mercy, loving, judging, sharing, measuring and giving. Paul's letter to the Corinthians also calls us to be the image of the "heavenly one." It's a challenge! And not something we only do during Lent: being the image of Christ by loving, openness, generosity and care of other folks. As the famous author Kathy Coffey writes in *Give Us This Day*, February edition, page 259:

Research shows that humans are hardwired for compassion. ... Helping others elevates oxytocin (the "feel-good" hormone) in the blood stream. ... The challenge is to find the Divine presence even in the enemy. In every "other" the sacred spark flares.

For those who may be "difficult" in our life or world, let's work on that hormone and demonstrate a bit more compassion this week. At least we will feel a lot better, even if they do not see the Divine Image in us. Remember, one step at a time in the process of sharing Christ's generosity with others!

The purpose of OCSAA is to strengthen Catholic school identity and mission and to engage Catholic schools in the ongoing improvement of student learning. I wanted to share a quick update on where our school is in the accreditation process. We completed our self-study last year, and our faculty has worked diligently to write our improvement plan. In October, Assistant Superintendent Tracey Arnone visited our school, completed the Internal Validation site visit, and reviewed our preliminary plan. On February 27 and 28, we will welcome Mr. Kevin Vance from the Archdiocese of Cincinnati, along with four other principals from the Diocese of Cleveland, for our External Validation Team site visit. They will spend two days with us touring the school, interviewing faculty members, evaluating our preliminary plan, and offering feedback before we submit our plan to OCSAA for approval.
