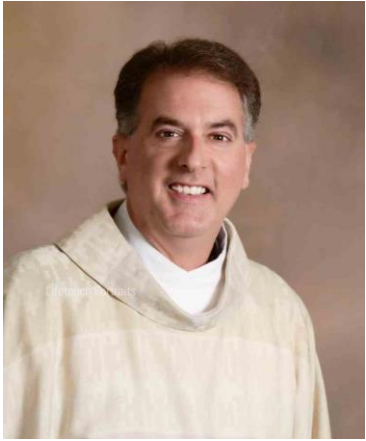

2nd Sunday of Lent: How have you been doing with your temptations this past week? Last weekend I preached a tad about the LORD'S Prayer, and how we pray that we are not led into temptation - and follow through on those temptations. Rather, with Lent's first two Sunday readings, we see that if we are able to work and grow through our temptations from Satan, we are transformed! Not giving in, but losing control to God is truly transformative, perhaps transfiguring? Because of Christ's experience on Mount Tabor, we

know that the disciples became fully awake. We, too, continue to climb the mountain with the LORD and explore where our faith is going. We may ask, "Where is God?" but the answer is right in front of us: the beloved, chosen Son of God is present, really present to us if we but listen. So, perhaps the transfiguration story is our story, about listening to God a bit more, and truly trusting Him. And, as Paul says to the Philippians in our readings - by being imitators of Christ, we conform to Christ to enjoy the joy of Christ. Happy listening!

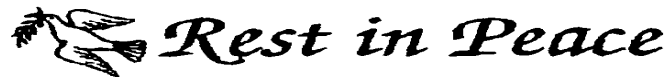
