### Your Lenten Challenge - Third Week of Lent

**Fasting:** In the first reading (Ex 17:3-7), the Israelites grumble and do not trust God. Give up grumbling and complaining this week.

**Prayer:** In the second reading (Rom 5:1-2, 5-8), Paul tells us that we have peace with God through Jesus. Pray for peace in your heart, in your home and in the world.

**Almsgiving:** In the Gospel (John 4:5-42), Jesus asks the woman at the well for a drink. In many parts of the world, people do not have clean water to drink. Use less water this week. Give to an organization that provides wells where needed, such as Catholic Relief Services.
