The meeting opened with all reading an opening prayer.

Three bids for repointing of chimney bricks on the rectory were presented.

1. Stu Krasavage Concrete \$11,900.00
2. Kemmerer Masonry \$10,800.00
3. Fabian Masonry \$6,500.00

It was decided to award the contract to Fabian Masonry by acclamation of the committee.

The bathrooms in the church need attention. Suggestions were painting, installing a changing table that folds to the wall and checking the ventilation.

The frames on ground level doors at the front of the church need to be replaced. Bids will be sought.

A quarterly statement of income and expenditures will be added to the bulletin. The October Statement will be comprised of July, August, and September's income and expenditures.

The 2016-2017 Budget was presented, reviewed and discussed.

Motion by John O'Malia, second by John Kurilla to adopt the 2016-2017 Budget as presented.

Motion carried on all ayes.
