For the past 40 years, high school youth from across the United States have had their faith awakened and their hearts set on a fire through a personal encounter with Jesus at a Steubenville Conference. This summer, over 54,000 teens and their leaders will be a part of this movement of grace at one of 25 conferences. This is the reflection of one teen from All Saints Parish who attended last weekend:

*“A decision to go to Steubenville, Ohio for a Catholic youth conference to be with the Lord for just a weekend is what I needed to strengthen my relationship with Him. I felt the support I needed from friends I met there, and I felt the love of God through His words and music during adoration and mass. I was a bit afraid to be to go be with 4,000 people for weekend as I had no idea what would happen, but having no expectations was what allowed me to completely hear what God is trying to tell me. At Steubenville I met the love of God as well as amazing people, and devoting three days to God resulted in that love which made it completely worth it. Last weekend was my third trip to Steubenville, and each time I go, I find different ways to devote my love to God. It makes every trip a new experience and it makes me want to go back. I encourage other teens like myself to go next summer to experience and feel what I felt there this past weekend, God's mercy and love.” (Therese Young)*
