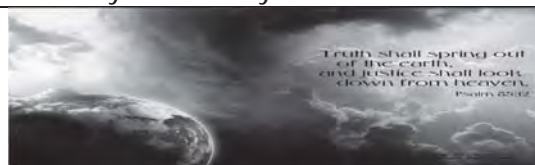

Our Church:

Our Church is our home. Yet many times we consider ourselves to be visitors of the Parish, and therefore we don't feel at home. We think of our faith as only being between us and God, without thinking that our faith includes others. We at times forget that it is through our Baptism that we are brothers and sisters in Christ, and therefore, we are ONE body in Christ. Our faith is communal, and therefore we are all responsible for taking care of each other and our Church.

Given this, we need to look at maintaining our home, that is our Church, and at improving what needs improving. Since things these days seem to cost a lot of money, we are going to take things a few steps at a time. Our first three projects are: 1. The exterior of the Church needs some care, including a coat of paint and the repair of water damage. 3. The parking lot needs a sealcoat to ensure that it does not continue to erode a fast rate.

While there are many other projects we have in mind, and while we are working on creating a thriving Parish Community through prayer, we need to be patient and take them a few at a time. With this, I ask for your help in these three projects. We need your help to make our Church a more beautiful and vibrant parish!

Please prayerfully consider helping us with the following needs:
Church Sound System:

The reason people come to St. Martin Parish is for the Mass. Plain and simple. Yet, what good is coming to Mass if you can't understand what the priest is saying? What about the readings? The Psalm? Yes, coming to Mass is always very good, but what if you could hear every word clearly? That would be great! Since we are aware that our priests, lectors, and choirs sometimes have accents, and our people don't always have perfect hearing, all compounded by our beautiful Church producing an echo, we realize that we need an update to our sound system. With all of the technology now available at a reasonable price, we have found a system that custom tailors the sound based on the priest, the lectors, the choir, and the number of people, or any combination thereof. That, coupled with more speakers along the walls will keep the sound level LOWER, while improving the CLARITY of the spoken word. How great is that? Based on a preliminary analysis, we need to raise **\$20,000** for a complete overhaul of our sound system. The good news is that we can use the current system for the Parish Hall so that we can have more community events there. Nothing is wasted. □□

Church Exterior Paint:

We will be painting the front of the Church, which as you have seen needs quite a bit of help. As soon as we get approval of the colors by the Diocesan art and environment committee we will start. Oh, and as soon as we get the bee problem under control! We need your help to paint the rest of the Church Exterior, since it's going to cost us around **\$12,000** to paint the entire exterior of the Church, and another **\$1000** to relocate the bees and remove the hives from inside the wall.

Church Parking Lot:

As most of you have seen, our parish office parking lot was recently redone and it looks great! Unfortunately the same cannot be said about our Church parking lot. While many think that it doesn't matter much if the parking lot is not in great shape, the reality is that if we do not maintain the asphalt with regular sealing, it will deteriorate very rapidly and soon require a much bigger expense. We also have a couple of big dips behind the church, and the need for some speed bumps to slow people down and make it safer for pedestrians. Also, a nice parking lot with clear lines makes parking a whole bunch easier! The cost for this project is **\$9000** and we need your support! □

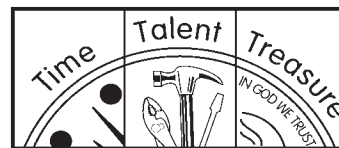

¡Necesitamos su ayuda para hacer mas bella a nuestra Iglesia y formar una parroquia vibrante! Les pido que consideren en oración ayudar a su parroquia en las siguientes necesidades:

- Sistema de Sonido de la Iglesia:**
La razón que viene el pueblo a la Parroquia de San Martín es por la Misa. Punto y final. ¿Aun, que bien puede traer el venir a Misa si no se entiende lo que dice el padre? ¿O las lecturas? ¿O el Salmo? Si claro, el venir a Misa siempre es algo muy bueno, pero ¡que bonito fuera si se podría entender cada palabra! ¡Eso fuera espectacular! Puesto que estamos consientes que nuestros sacerdotes, lectores, y coros a veces tienen acentos, junto con la realidad que algunos parroquianos no oyen muy bien, complicado por el hecho de que nuestro templo causa dificultades con sonido, pues tenemos claro que necesitamos mejorar nuestro sistema de sonido. Con toda la tecnología que hay a un precio razonable, hemos encontrado un sistema que hace ajustes según la voz del padre, los lectores, el coro, la cantidad de gente, y muchas otras combinaciones! Eso, junto con la instalación de mas bocinas por las paredes nos ayudara a tener un sonido de volumen mas BAJO, siendo al mismo tiempo mas CLARO. ¿Que bien no? Basado en un análisis preliminar, necesitamos juntar \$20,000 para completar este proyecto. Lo bueno es que nada se desperdicia, y podremos usar el sistema de hoy en el salón parroquial para eventos de la comunidad.
- La Pintada del Exterior de la Iglesia:**
Estaremos pintando la parte del frente de la Iglesia, la cual si se han fijado necesita mucha ayuda. En cuanto nos de la aprobación la diócesis de los colores, empezaremos. ¡Y aparte nos falta controlar el problema de las abejas! Necesitamos su ayuda para pintar el resto del exterior de templo, pues nos va a costar mas o menos \$12,000 en pintar todo el exterior, mas aparte \$1000 para cambiar las abejas a otro lugar y mover las columnas del interior de las paredes.
- El Estacionamiento de la Iglesia**
Como la mayoría de ustedes han visto, recientemente se le ha puesto una capa selladora al estacionamiento de la oficina y ¡se ve muy bien! Desafortunadamente no podemos decir lo mismo del estacionamiento de la Iglesia. Aunque muchos piensan que no importa si se ve feo el estacionamiento, la realidad es que si no se mantiene regularmente con capas nuevas que sellan el asfalto, empieza a deteriorarse muy rápidamente y llegaran gastos fuertes mucho mas pronto que lo normal. También hay unos hoyos que hay que arreglar, mas agregar unos topes para que no haya peligro para el peatón. Es mas, un estacionamiento bonito, con líneas claras y brillantes, ¡hará mas fácil el acto de estacionarse! El costo de este proyecto es de \$9000 y necesitamos su apoyo!
