FROM THE PASTOR.....

Sometimes we may think of God as a vending machine, someone who gives us stuff. If I do this then I will get this. If I pray these prayers and novena then this will happen. By this way of thinking, it would mean that we know better than God, or we know what His plan is and we have tamed Him. God can't do things that are not good for us in the long term, because that wouldn't be love. He is not a vending machine God who just gives without care or understanding the consequences. What is Jesus when you really get down to it? If he is only a teacher, then his teaching can be understood in different ways by emphasizing one aspect and ignoring others. The problem is that Jesus' teachings must be taken together as a whole. It is a dishonest thing to start with an idea and then force the Bible to defend it. If He is a miracle worker, that is nice because we all want miracles to change our physical health. We can all accept Him if that is the case. If He is merely a good model or a good guy, then we all have our response to Him and how we will treat Him. If He is a mad man or insane, then we don't have to listen to Him and we should do the opposite of what He preached. What is He really? St. Peter tells us in our Gospel this weekend: He is the Christ the Savior. If God has sent a Savior, it is because we need saving. Saving from what you may ask, because I am a good person. A savior from our broken human condition. That is what He is saving us from, our broken human condition. We may think "I am not broken. I am a good person." Perhaps, but we need to ask ourselves these questions: Can you keep Ten Commandments without fail? Can you always avoid sin? Can you follow the moral teaching of the Church? Is your will in conformity with the Will of God? Can you keep the Law of God which guards the dignity and integrity of the Human person? Are you able to deny yourself and take up your cross and follow Christ? If you're honest with yourself you know the answer to many of those questions is no, it is impossible, you cannot do so on your own and so all of us are always in need of a Savior. This is the only honest way to look at our Lord Jesus as the Savior for those of us caught in broken humanity.

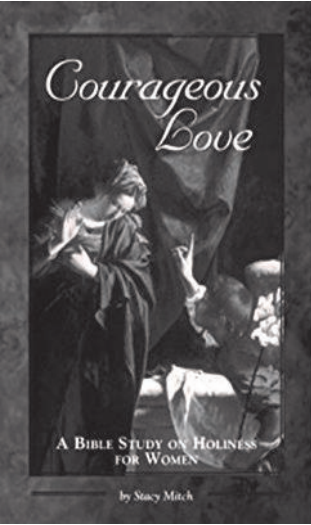
