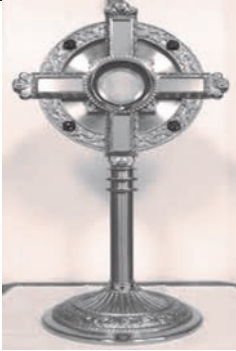
ST. VINCENT DE PAUL

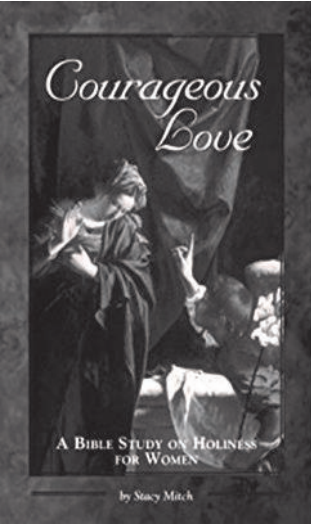
