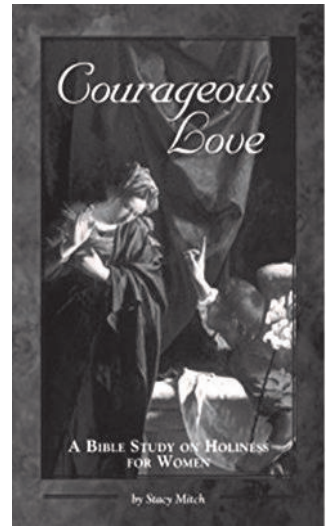


CATHOLIC STUDIES NIGHT

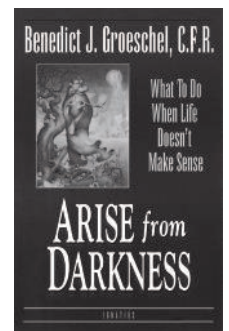
