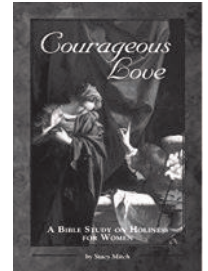

Fr. Ignatius will be preaching at the 5:30 pm Mass on Saturday, **December 8, 2018**.

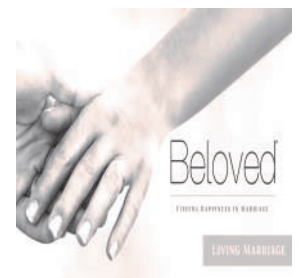
