## FROM THE PASTOR.....

Here is an update on some of the things happening here at our parish. First of all, our Knights of Columbus, headed by John Montoya will soon begin to work on our kitchen to lay a new floor and to get that space ready for some new fixtures. If everything goes as planned we should have a new kitchen by late May or June. So slowly but surely we will get our various projects done. The bathrooms will be tackled next, but we will have to raise a little bit more money for that as we do have to replace our roofs over the gathering space, the kitchen and the auditorium. Speaking of the roofs, we are going with a synthetic material which is durable but which will save us some money as opposed to the traditional tar and gravel method. The problem however with the synthetic layer is that shedding pine needles from our trees would severely effect the new roofs and since our pine trees in our courtyard are shedding terribly because quite frankly they are dying, we have no choice but to have them cut down. It's going to be sad to see those trees gone but there is no getting around it. The amount of pine needles on our roofs is enormous. Also, the two younger trees in front of our church will also be cut down because they have become far too messy but also they have gotten to the point where they are blocking the view of our church complex. Hardly a month goes by when someone doesn't come up to me and tells me, "I didn't know you guys were here." Or, "I didn't know there was a Catholic Church here on campus." That's because you can't see the place! When I was a student here at UNM you could see the Aquinas Newman Center from a long distance away. So we are just doing some early spring cleaning to make ourselves more presentable and of course to make sure that the money we spend on our new roofs will not be wasted.
