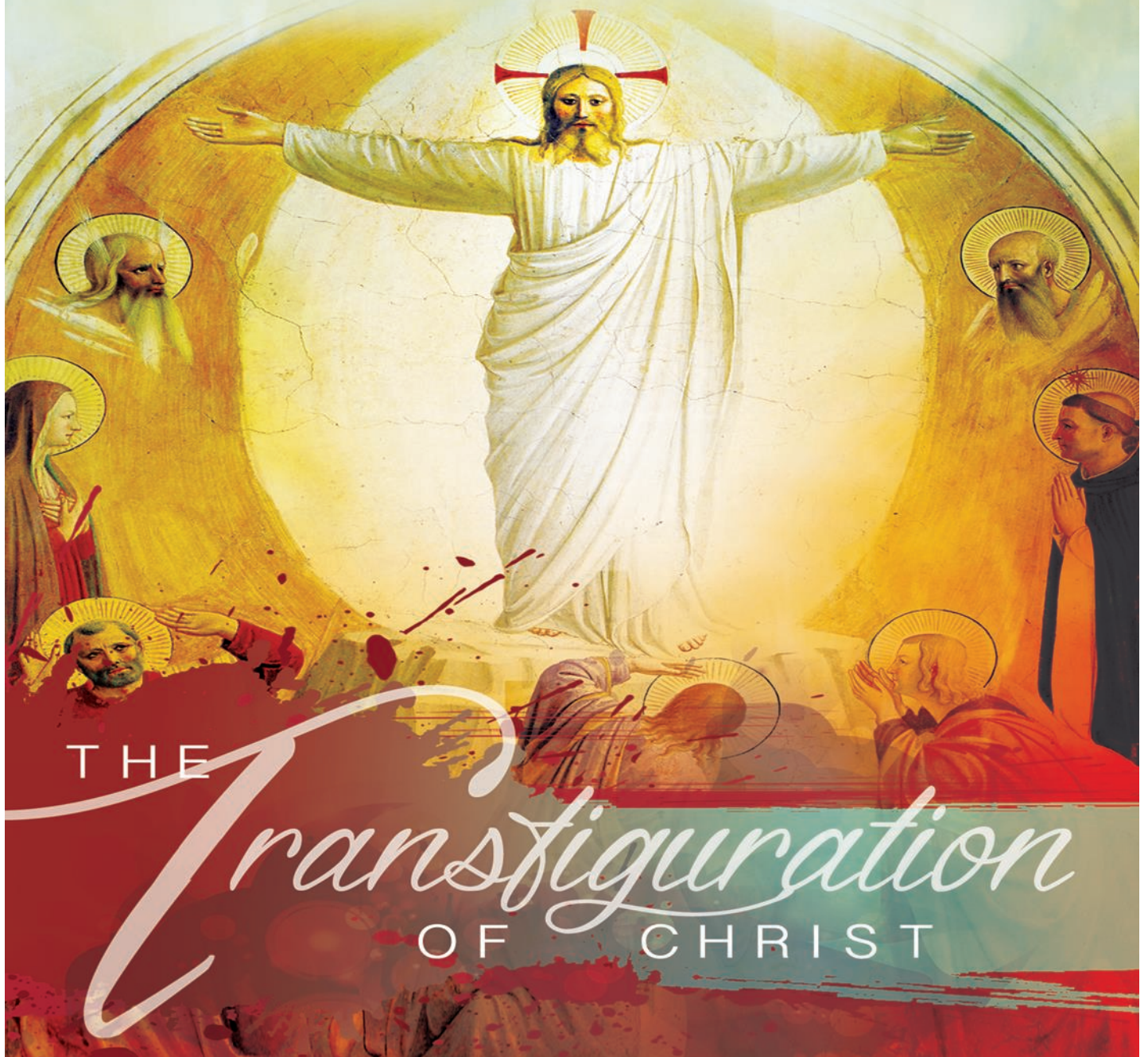

FROM THE PASTOR.....

Pope St. John Paul II once said concerning our Gospel today which is the transfiguration of the Lord: "The transfiguration is not only the revelation of Christ's glory, but also a preparation for facing Christ's cross. It involves both 'going up the mountain' and 'coming down the mountain.' The disciples who have enjoyed this intimacy with the Master, surrounded for a moment by the splendor of the Trinitarian life... are invited to return to the valley, to share with Jesus the toil of God's plan and to set off courageously on the way of the cross." The Transfiguration should give us inspiration and hope. Everyday we run into problems, difficulties and trials in life. But in the middle of all these, we are reminded that the Lord we are following is a victorious Lord, the beloved Son of the Father. All our troubles in this world are passing. Our final destiny is glory, victory and eternal happiness. It is like reading a novel in which the happy ending is already known to us. No matter how difficult are the problems that the main characters in the novel have to face, we are not discouraged because we know the story will have a happy ending. As we always say, "All is well that ends well!" The same is true with our life as Christians. We know that with Jesus our happy ending is coming if we but stay with him and continue to live our lives in him, all the while letting our Lord transfigure our own lives. As St. Paul said: "The sufferings of the present are as nothing compared with the glory to be revealed in us" (Rom 8:18). Sufferings are part of our life, especially as we closely follow the Crucified Lord. But these are the key to our final victory and glory.
