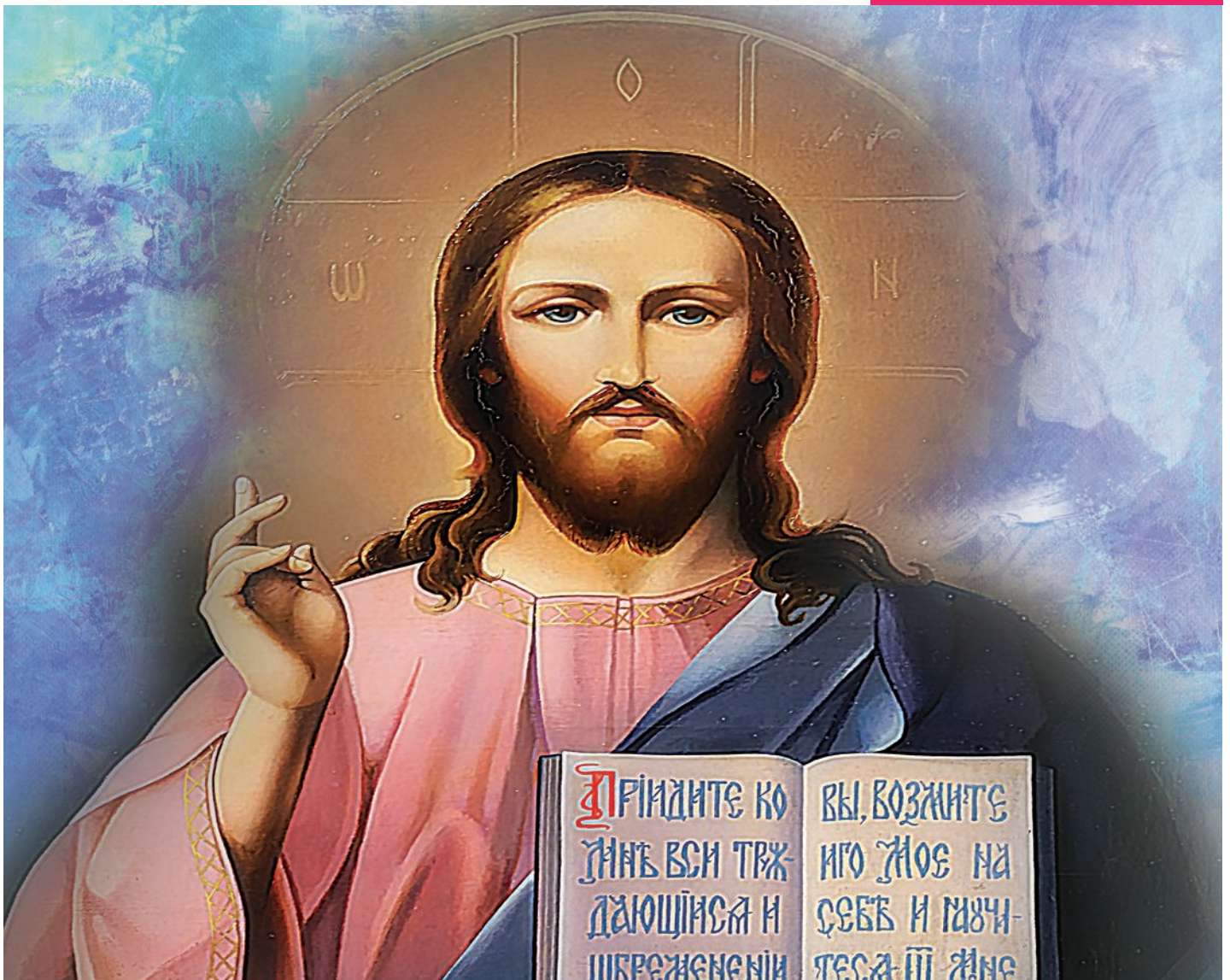

FROM THE PASTOR.....

Today we celebrate Laetare Sunday. We are getting closer in our journey towards Easter as today is now the halfway point of Lent. Laetare, means "to rejoice." The Church, in her wisdom, gives us this time of rejoicing, almost like a pit stop, so that we may stop and think about the purpose of our journey. Lent is a season of self-examination, fasting and penance. And for those of you who have given up certain things--the sweets, the special foods, the Netflix!--for those of you who have been consistent in your devotions the question today is: Why should we be happy, why should we rejoice? We are happy because we are reminded today that our efforts are not in vain! We are moving towards the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. Our time spent doing works of charity or being nicer to others is not wasted. We are rejoicing today because we are almost there, we can see the light at the end of the tunnel.

Something not commonly known about the liturgy is that each Mass has a theme set by the first reading and the Gospel, and the theme for this Laetare Sunday definitely holds cause for rejoicing. The Liturgy of the Word starts with Joshua 5: the end of the Israelites' 40 years in the desert draws near and they no longer eat manna, but food from Canaan, the Promised Land from God. The Gospel reading is the beloved story of the Prodigal Son; similar to Joshua, it speaks joyfully to the fulfilled promises of God the Father's mercy and forgiveness. So hang in there, and continue to rejoice. All that we've been through, all that we still have to accomplish is totally worth it as we get closer to the great and holy day that is the Resurrection of the Lord.
