Jesus said, "Neither do I condemn you. Go, and from now on do not sin any more." - Jn 8:11b

FROM THE PASTOR.....

So what are some of the things that we can learn from this weekend's Gospel of the woman caught in adultery? (John 8: 1-11) First, judge yourself before you judge anyone else. Don't be hypocritical. Second, put your rock down! Our Lord Jesus alone is the only one without sin and he is the only one who can properly judge the motives of someone's heart. Third, Jesus was punished so that you can be set free. Our Lord has taken our place on the Cross to die for our sins, so that we would not die but have life in him. Fourth, Jesus lifts away our condemnation. For those of us who can live totally in Christ Jesus, there is no condemnation; he has restored you, he has given you a new life. Fifth, Jesus gives us dignity. Not only does Jesus forgive the woman caught in adultery as he forgives us when we come sincerely repentant to him, but he gives us back our lives and our dignity as a son or daughter of God. And finally, Jesus as we see through this Gospel encounter always points us back to the God the Father, always sets our course back home to Him. That is why he told the woman as he tells us, "Go and from now on sin no more."
