FROM THE PASTOR.....

There is a lot going on this weekend with Sunday being both Mother's Day as well as the World Day of Prayer for Vocations. Here are a few thoughts from the folks at Vianney Vocations, a group that works towards fostering more priestly vocations: St. Mother Teresa once said, "I used to pray that God would feed the hungry, or do this or that, but now I pray that he will guide me to do whatever I'm supposed to do, what I can do. I used to pray for answers, but now I'm praying for strength. I used to believe that prayer changes things, but now I know that prayer changes us and we change things." Rather than praying that God calls more men and women, we need to pray instead that more people answer! For we don't have a crisis of vocations, what we do have is a lack of answers to God's call. Why pray for vocations? It's simple: if we don't, we are failing to do something that Jesus told us to do. He said to "Beg the harvest master to send forth more laborers..." Now Some may ask, "How can we encourage vocations to the priesthood when so many priests have behaved so badly?" The answer is that bad shepherds highlight the need for good shepherds. Now is exactly the time to challenge young men to become good, holy priests for the Church.
