FROM THE PASTOR.....

Our Gospel this weekend again comes from the Gospel of John. Like last week, today we hear words spoken by Jesus before his death and Resurrection. Jesus is teaching at the Last Supper. John's Gospel does not include a description of the first Eucharist as the other Gospels do; instead, Jesus washes his disciples' feet. Immediately after, Jesus predicts his betrayal by Judas. Today's Gospel follows that prediction. It can be read as a continuing explanation of Jesus' act of washing his disciples' feet. It begins with the announcement that this is the moment when the Son of Man will be glorified. This theme continues throughout John's description of the Passion of our Lord. Jesus will be glorified in his death on the cross and in his Resurrection, and the disciples will glorify Jesus in the love they show. And that's the main message: the love that we show. John's Gospel does not present a sentimental view of love. Rather, we see love that is shown in service and sacrifice. Now as we all know, it is quite difficult to choose to love when faced with hatred and anger. But Jesus tells the disciples, and he tells us, that others will know that we are his disciples because of the love we show for one another. This description of the early Christian community will be repeated in the Acts of the Apostles: "See how they love one another." Christian love is the hallmark of Christianity. We see it lived in the witness of the martyrs. We see it in the example of the lives of the saints. We see it in the holy women and men who live and love daily, making small and large sacrifices for others. Though it may be difficult at times, love, the true love that we receive from our Lord himself is not only what makes us Christians, it is what makes us effective as Christians.

HIGH SCHOOL CONFIRMATION

The Archdiocese has changed the Confirmation program to 2 years of catechesis. If you have a child that is going into 8th or 9th grade in the Fall, they may attend the summer CCD program this June or July to complete year one of Confirmation. If they do attend this Summer session, only those in the 9th grade may register for the Confirmation class in the Fall for year 2, and be Confirmed in May, 2020.
