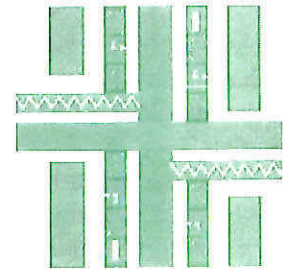

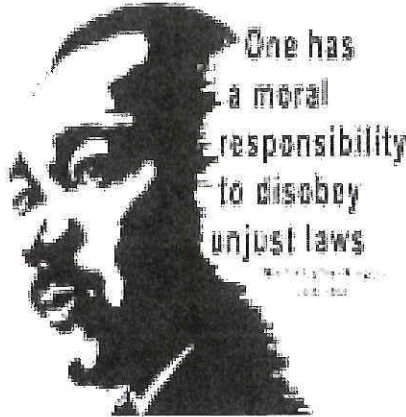
LIVING AS THE BODY OF CHRIST
