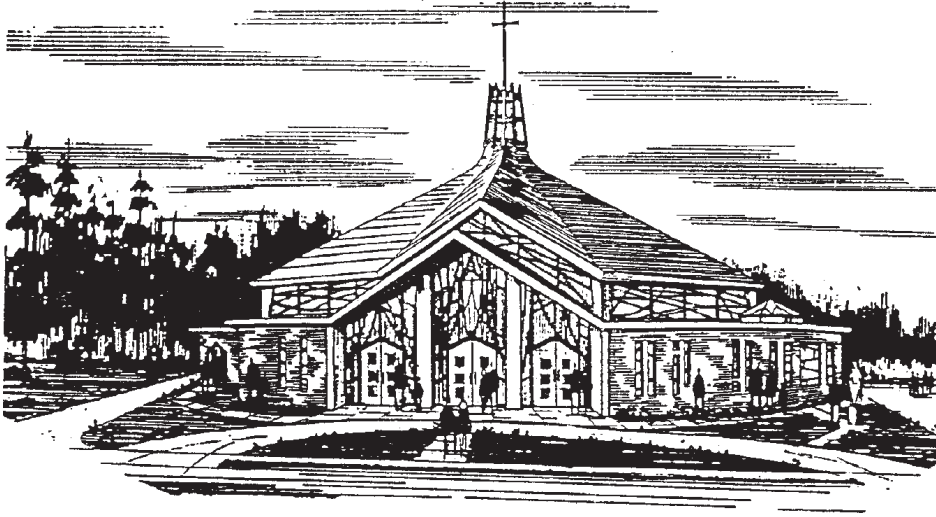

Message from the Pastor:

On behalf of Father Marek, the Parish Staff and myself, I would like to thank everyone who contributed their time, talent and generosity during our Holy Week celebrations -- from the beautiful scenery design and construction, the flower arrangements and displays, the wonderful music and angelic voices of the choir, to the firemen who set-up the Easter fire and our youth group who prepared the candles for the Easter Vigil Mass. We so appreciate all the hard work and dedication to everyone involved in beautifying our church and enriching our liturgies for all to partake in and enjoy!

Today, the Second Sunday or Octave Day of Easter, John tells us in the gospel how the Risen Christ greets his fearful disciples with peace, commissions them to carry on his mission, and breathes his Spirit upon them. They are overwhelmed with joy. Thomas who was not with them refuses to believe until he is able to see and touch Jesus for himself. A week later, Jesus appears and invites Thomas to see and touch him. Overwhelmed by the Risen Christ, Thomas makes one of the most profound belief statements by addressing Jesus as "My Lord and my God." Jesus proceeds to praise all those like ourselves who have not seen, and yet, have believed. Easter Time allows us the time to deepen our faith and intimate relationship with the Risen Christ.

This Sunday also is Divine Mercy Sunday. Established by Pope (Saint) John Paul II in the year 2000, it leads us into the continuing celebration of God's mercy during Easter Time. Let us pray, through the intercession of St. Faustina, that God's mercy and compassion will have neither limits nor boundaries in the trials and tribulations of our tumultuous world of today.
