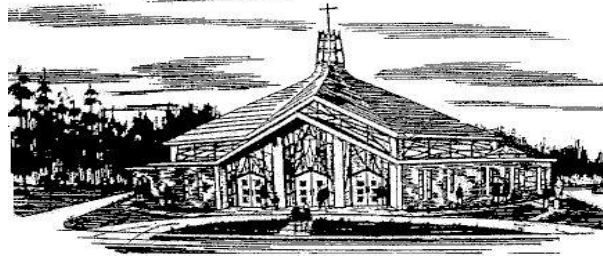

Message from the Pastor:

First, I would like to extend my congratulations and blessings to all our children who received their Confirmation this past Friday. Confirmation completes the Sacrament of Initiation and brings the gifts of the Holy Spirit alive in us so that we can take all that we have learned and who we have become and apply it in action -- full of faith and hope that what God has planned for us will come to be through the power of His Spirit. I pray that you will be closer to God and become more aware of God in your daily lives. I also want to thank Bishop David Arias, OAR, from the Archdiocese of Newark who blessed us with presence today; Sister Eileen O'Farrell, RCD; the parish staff; volunteers; parents; godparents and sponsors who worked so hard preparing our children in this process of formation.

Today, the 4th Sunday of Easter is also Good Shepherd Sunday. As the good shepherd, Jesus contrasts himself with the hired hand – one who works for pay and is not concerned for his sheep. Jesus desires us all to be one, loving and caring for one another the way He freely and willingly cares for us. The whole Easter mystery reveals to us how utterly faithful God is in loving us. We can be faithful in our own loving because God is faithful in loving us. Jesus is the Good Shepherd. So are we to be.

In 1963 Pope Paul VI designated Good Shepherd Sunday as the “World Day of Prayer for Vocations”. The Church invites us to honor the vocation of all Christians given at baptism.

May we who have dedicated our lives to God through the vocation of marriage, priesthood, diaconate, consecrated life, and the single life remain faithful to our commitments.

Pope Francis ends his message for the 52nd Word Day of Prayer with this:

“The Virgin Mary, model of every vocation, did not fear to utter her “*fiat*” in response to the Lord’s call. She is at our side and she guides us. With the generous courage born of faith, Mary sang of the joy of leaving herself behind and entrusting to God the plans she had for her life. Let us turn to her, so that we may be completely open to what God has planned for each one of us, so that we can grow in the desire to go out with tender concern towards others (cf. *Lk 1:39*). May the Virgin Mary protect and intercede for us all.”

Let us all pray to the Immaculate Heart of Mary in our daily prayers!

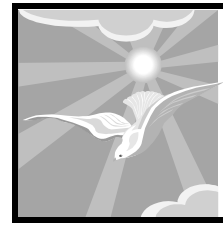
